

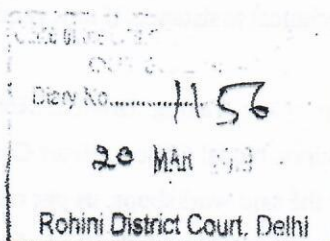

Sudden death is preceded by symptoms in preceding one hour in 80% cases but symptoms are often unrecognized or minimized by patients.

51 percent patients have warning symptoms within four weeks preceding cardiac arrest and eighty percent of patients experience symptoms at least one hour before sudden cardiac arrest and 34 percent having symptoms more than 24 hours before the arrest. Also, timely CPR and cardiac shock can save upto 50% of cases.


