Dear Shri Baijal ji,

A review of implementation of reforms for improving India's rank in World Bank's Doing Business Report was taken by the Hon'ble Prime Minister on 13th December, 2018. India was ranked at 166th out of 190 economies for Doing Business indicator 'Registering Property'. World Bank's evaluation parameters for indicator include a number of procedures involved in registering a property, cost and time associated with the procedures and 'quality of land administration index'. Under this indicator, the State Government of NCT of Delhi had committed to reduce the number of procedures to 4, time required to 25 days and improve the measure of quality to a score of 20. The same is recorded in Minutes of the review undertaken by Hon'ble Prime Minister issued vide PMO ID No. 300/31/C/5/2018 ES-I dated 30th January, 2019.

Government of Maharashtra has submitted multiple reforms for Mumbai this year with an aim to improve the ease the property registration process and reduce cost associated with it. However, no reforms were claimed by Government of NCT of Delhi despite continuous follow-up by this Ministry. Even officers attending meetings in DPIIT were found unaware of this commitment and had no inkling about reforms need to be implemented by Government of NCT of Delhi.

It is critical to implement the reforms by departments concerned in Dulhi (refer annexure) by December 2019, for the users to experience the change by 01st May, 2020 (end of assessment period for next report). There are important issues pertaining to this indicator where action is long overdue and immediate intervention is required from respective Departments in Delhi.

It is important that a nodal officer at senior level is nominated by the Government of NCT of Delhi to work as point of contact for all 'Ease of Doing Business' related matters for Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT). Further, there is a need to educate and build capacity of the officers concerned to implement it.e reform measures.
