Directions/guidelines for compliance by Judicial Officers. Sub:

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to say that Hon'ble the then Acting Chief Justice has been pleased to order that all the District & Sessions Judges shall ensure equitable distribution of complex cases involving multiple accused and multiple charges.

Hon'ble the then Acting Chief Justice has also been pleased to pass the following directions/guidelines for compliance by the judicial officers :-

- 1. Old cases should be taken up on priority basis. Long adjournments should not be given as a matter of rule in such cases. The adjournment should not be given merely at the asking of the accused unless the Court is satisfied that the matter cannot be proceeded with at all for the reasons given by the counsel.
- The Court should not give unnecessary adjournments for works like supply of deficit copies, filing of written arguments and additional charge sheet etc.
- Misc. Applications should be dealt with on top priority preferably the same day so as to curb frivolous applications delaying the trial.
- 4. Long adjournments should not be granted in old cases. Case should be adjourned preferably for next day for further arguments, where the arguments are not concluded in one hearing and to be taken up day to day till hearing is completed.
- 5. Adjournment should not be given because of the absence of one of the accused where there are number of accused in a case. If the identity of the accused is not disputed the accused may be exempted for that day through the counsel and the matter be proceeded with e.g. The presence of the accused is to necessary to hear the arguments on charge or for supply of deficit copies; or the witness present may not be a witness material to the accused who is absent etc.

I am therefore to request you to kindly bring the above directions/guidelines of Hon'ble the then Acting Chief Justice to the notice of all judicial officers under your control for information & necessary compliance.
