They may, subject to the condition that at least one of them remains on duty, avail themselves of the special casual leave on dates falling between the 31st May and 15th July, 1976(both days inclusive).

The date from which each officer proceeds on special casual leave should be communicated to this Court. It should be borne in mind that the period of special casual leave taken which should be continuous, must include all holidays so that no officer remains absent from his station for more than 23 days.
