

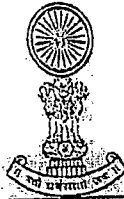

1.	To consider and monitor the pendency and disposal of cases in the POCSO Courts.	<p>Discussed. As per the pendency chart the case pending for more than 5 years in 552.</p> <p>Resolved that these 522 cases shall be disposed of by the target date of 31.01.2020.</p> <p>POCSO Court shall give a list of more than 5 years old cases indicating the stage at which each case is, next date of hearing, whether there is a stay by the High court in the matter, accused is in custody etc. as per format Annexure-A.</p> <p>It has also been pointed out that the expeditious disposal of cases is hampered because of non-availability of Public Prosecutor. Substitute Public Prosecutor are not present when the regular Public Prosecutor attached to POCSO courts are not available or on leave. The Director Prosecution be asked to look into the issue urgently and resolve the same.</p> <p>XX XX XX</p> <p>As per <i>e mail</i> letter no. EC/54/2013 dated 16/07/2013 received from E-Committee, Supreme Court (Annexure-B), the information of cases relating to Sexual offences against women and children must not be uploaded on the website.</p> <p>XX XX XX</p> <p>The abovementioned <i>e-mail</i> letter from the <i>E-Committee</i>, Supreme Court be also mentioned when displaying the above data besides mentioning that parties may apply for certified copies of the judgment/order to the concerned Court as per rules.</p>
2.	Award of compensation to victim by POCSO Courts.	<p>The POCSO Courts shall wherever required award of compensation to victims under Section 33 of the POCSO Act as also under Section 357-A of Cr.PC while maintaining uniformity as per the well settled legal principles.</p> <p>A one day workshop shall be organized within a month by the District & Sessions Judge (HQ) in the Delhi High Court for sensitization of Presiding Officers of the POCSO Courts on the aspect of award of compensation to the victim.</p> <p>The District & Session Judge (HQ) shall identify the bottlenecks and their possible solutions in the adjudication of POCSO cases for the purpose of discussion in the workshop.</p> <p>XX XX XX</p>

Dear CPC,

With reference to the subject and referred letter given above, the undersigned is directed to reiterate that, the activity of uploading the case data for the ecourtindia portal is supposed to be a daily routine. It is therefore requested to give top priority to this updation of data on daily basis so as to avoid out-dated information on ecourtindia portal.

It is further requested not to upload case related information of cases relating to matrimonial matters (Family Courts), Juvenile Justice Act, Official Secrets Act, matters relating to Intelligence Agencies, matters relating to domestic violence and sexual offences against women & children etc.

It is also hereby informed that, a mechanism in the Core version of CIS is being worked out for such cases so that only the case number and its status will be made available on the internet to avoid any embarrassment to any of the parties.
