MINUTES

At the outset, the Ld Chairperson welcomes the Hon'ble members.

The order dated 04.09.2019 of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 8106/2010 titled as *P. K. Dash Adv. & Ors. VS. Bar Council of Delhi & Ors* has been received from Ld. Govt. Counsel Shri Sanjay Diwan, Advocate. As per the aforesaid order, the Hon'ble High Court has directed the Election Commission to give a realistic schedule within one week and place the same on record so as to enable the Hon'ble court to take a final decision with regard to conduct the election of Rohini Court Bar Association (R.C.B.A.). In view of the order, the Committee is of the unanimous opinion that the task of announcing the schedule be completed by the Election Commission in terms of Hon'ble High Court order and no further action is required in this regard at the end of this Committee.

The Committee has unanimously decided to start with the task mandated in the judgment of Hon'ble High Court in Writ Petition (Civil) No. 8106/2010 titled as *P. K. Dash Adv. & Ors. VS. Bar Council of Delhi & Ors*. As per the aforesaid judgment, the following tasks are to be performed by the Committee:-

- 1. Verifying the Declaration Forms submitted by the members.
- 2. Preparation of the provisional list of eligible voters.
- 3. Display of the Provisional List so prepared for calling objections, if any.
- 4. Preparation of Final List of Voters four Weeks before the Date of Election.

The issue has been deliberated upon. The committee is of the opinion that the declaration form filed during the last election had some bogus entries which had consumed lot of time during verification. The same needs to be avoided by putting necessary mechanism in force while calling for such declaration forms.

Regarding the time period to be granted to the members of the Bar for filing of declaration forms and to the RCBA for collection thereof, the members have expressed their opinion that keeping in view that there are around 7,500 members of the Bar, sufficient time should be granted for the same. It has also been discussed that the process being

initiated now, the month of October being festival month, there are a number of vacations owing to which some of the outstation members may even go to their respective native places. The members are of unanimous opinion that reasonable time should be granted. Besides above, the members have strongly felt that before starting the process, at least a week's time should be granted to the RCBA for necessary preparation.

After due deliberations, the following decisions are unanimously taken:-

- The format of Declaration Form shall be in accordance with the judgment of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi as formulated in P.K.Dash's case (Supra). The format used in the last election is hereby approved.
- Each Declaration Form shall be numbered, the number being mentioned on the top left side of the Form.
- All the entries of the Declaration Form should be filled in with the declaration being signed by the members in blue. Incomplete Form should not be accepted.
- The photograph pasted on the top right side of the form should be original photograph of the member and not merely its computerised image, as was found in some cases during the last election.
- The photograph should be signed by the member in such a manner that half of the signature come on the form and the other half on the photograph (preferably with the CD Marker/indelible ink).

6. The schedule for the process shall be as under:-

- 8. The Declaration Form shall be collected and consolidated in a bunch of 150 each and be submitted by RCBA to the office of Election Committee (Mediation Centre Room No.408 4th Floor, Rohini Courts Complex Delhi).
- 9. The Computer Entry of each form should be made by the RCBA in an excel sheet and should be submitted in both hard and soft copy (Pen Drive).
- 10. The provisional as well as the final list shall be displayed on the website by the Computer Branch by creating necessary links.
- Objection Form as prepared during last election shall remain the same and be made available by the RCBA and be consolidated daywise and submitted by the RCBA to the office of Election Committee accordingly.
