ORDER


Consequent upon the directions in Order No. 16/DHC/2020 dated 13.06.2020 received from Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, it is directed that the Judicial Officer whose name is mentioned in column no. 'A' shall hear and dispose of all the urgent criminal matters pertaining to the police station as mentioned in Column No. B. The Judicial Officer whose name is mentioned in Column No. A shall also deal with Civil matters of pecuniary jurisdiction of ADJ pertaining to North-West District. The Judicial Officer whose name is mentioned in column no. 'C' shall dispose of all the criminal matters pertaining to the police station as mentioned in Column No 'D' on 15th June 2020:


- The undersigned shall be available on the above said date for administrative work.
- Except as modified herein, the process of deciding urgency of matter, procedure for listing & hearing of urgent matter through Video Conferencing and other guidelines shall remain to be continued as per directions/additional directions laid down by undersigned vide order dated 8th April 2020 (<https://districts.ecourts.gov.in/sites/default/files/Order%20for%20video%20conferencing%20new%201%281%29.pdf>) & No. D&SJ(N&N-W)/Sectt./RC/2020/14475-14560 dated 21st April 2020 (<https://districts.ecourts.gov.in/sites/default/files/Additional%20directions%20qua%20listing%20and%20hearing%20of%20urgent%20matters%20throug%20video%20Conferencing%20.pdf>). The additional directions issued by the undersigned vide order no. D&SJ/Sectt.(North & NW)/RC/2020/16817-16891 dated 17th May 2020, D&SJ/Sectt.(North & NW)/RC/2020/16892-16967 dated 17th May 2020 & D&SJ/Sectt.(North & NW)/RC/2020/16968-17042 dated 17th May 2020 shall also be complied with by the Duty Judge(s) and all the concerned branches. - The Duty Judge shall deal only with the matters which require an urgent hearing viz. urgent stay matters, urgent matters of civil/criminal jurisdictions, urgent matters under Rent Control Act (Court of ADJ's Level) and all bail applications of North West District.



4. Henceforth, all the Lawyers/Litigants are requested to file the matters in soft form (in pdf format and as single document only) through e-mail to the following emails :-

5. The softcopy of the matter received in the manner prescribed above uptill 1:00PM shall be listed on the next working day and the remaining matters received after 1:00PM shall be listed on the subsequent working day.
6. It shall be the duty of Branch Incharge, Filing Section, Rohini Courts, Delhi to inform qua the listing of matter to Lawyer/Litigant.
7. The Reader of the concerned Duty Judge(s) shall inform the timing of hearing to the Lawyers/Litigants.
8. The Duty Judge shall hold the hearing of the urgent matters/cases preferably through Video-Conferencing via CISCO-WEBEX and shall come to the Court only when it is indispensable.
9. The Reader of the Ld. Duty Judge shall also ensure the Video Conferencing through CISCO Webex platform is organized by him. He shall send the URL/Meeting ID to all concern. In case of any difficulty the Reader of the concerned Duty Judge shall be assisted by the Branch Incharge/official of Computer Branch, Rohini Courts, Delhi so as to avoid any inconvenience to them.
10. Ms. Geeta Manocha, AO(J) appointed by Ld. District & Sessions Judge (HQrs) shall supervise the Filing Work of North West District, Rohini Courts, Delhi.
11. Ms. Savita Kumari AO(J) shall work as link of Ms. Geeta Manocha, AO(J).
12. The Duty Judge shall preferably call only those staff who are residing in Delhi.
13. In the eventuality of non-availability of the undersigned due to any reason, the senior most Judicial Officer available on the particular day shall act as Officiating District & Sessions Judge and shall look after the Administrative Work of the North-West District. However, any correspondence with the Hon'ble High Court and other Ld. District & Sessions Judge(s) shall be made only with the prior telephonic concurrence of the undersigned.
14. Lawyers/Litigants are requested to use Video-Conferencing for addressing the arguments so that overcrowding is avoided and social distancing is also maintained. Order regarding procedure to be followed to address the arguments via video conferencing is already uploaded on the website of North-West District, Rohini Courts.
15. If any Lawyer/Litigant is not in a position to handle video-conferencing from his/her respective homes/offices then he/she can avail facility of addressing arguments through video-conferencing from R.No.16 (Bar Room) at Ground Floor, Main Court Building, Rohini Courts Complex which has been made functional.
16. Sh. Raman Gupta, Branch Incharge, Computer Branch, Rohini Courts (Mob. 9212913427) and/ or his technical team (011-27554439) can be contacted for the purpose of hearing of arguments via video-conferencing.
17. The Duty Judge, whose name is mentioned in column no. 'A', shall hold the court in R. No. 106, 1st Floor, Rohini Courts, Delhi.
18. The Duty Judge, whose name is mentioned in column no. 'C', shall hold the Court in R. No. 105, 1st Floor, Rohini Courts, Delhi.
19. The Duty Judge is requested to ensure that the norms of social distancing is strictly adhered to.
