Filling up of 15 vacancies (14 existing and 01 anticipated) under Rule 7(1)(b) and 7B of Delhi Higher Judicial Service Rules, 1970, for recruitment to the post in the cadre of District Judge at Entry Level in the 10% quota of promotion through Limited Competitive Examination.

Sir/Madam.

I am directed to inform you that it has been decided to fill up 15 vacancies (14 existing and 01 anticipated) in the cadre of District Judge at Entry Level, under Rule 7(1)(b) of Delhi Higher Judicial Service Rules, 1970 by promotion strictly on the basis of merit through Limited Competitive Examination of Officers of the following categories:

- (a) Officers who have qualified service of 7 years [5 years as Civil Judge (Junior Division) and 2 years as Civil Judge (Senior Division)].
- (b) Officers who have qualified service of 10 years as Civil Judge (Junior Division).
- (c) Officers who have rendered more than 10 years of combined service in Junior Division and Senior Division but have not completed either 10 years of service in Junior Division or 2 years of service in Senior Division.

The selection will be made on the basis of the Written Examination, Assessment of Record and Viva Voce as per the following scheme mentioned in Rule 7B of Delhi Higher Judicial Service Rules, 1970:

Written Examination (i)

- 600 Marks

Assessment of Record (ii)

- 150 Marks

(iii) Viva Voce

- 250 Marks

The last date of receipt of the willingness shall be 30.07.2022.

All the Officers who have completed qualified regular service in any of the above three categories as on 30.07.2022 are eligible to compete. Any officer having grading as 'C' (Integrity Doubtful) in any year, shall not be eligible to appear in the Limited Competitive Examination.
