Sub- Revised limits of mobile phone facility to the Judicial Officers

Sir,

I am directed to convey the approval of the Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Delhi for the revised limits of mobile phone facility to the Judicial Officers as per the following details:-

Sl. No.	Designation	Maximum cost of mobile phone	Maximum monthly mobile charges
1.	Pr. Secretary (Law) & District Judge (Super Time Scale) (Rs. 70290-1540-76450)	Rs. 30,000/-	Upto Rs. 2,500/- per month
2.	District Judge (Selection Grade) (Rs. 57700-1230-58930-1380-67210-1540-70290)	Rs. 25,000/-	Upto Rs. 2,000/- per month
3.	District Judge (Entry Level) (Rs. 51550-1230-58930-1380-63070)	Rs. 25,000/-	Upto Rs. 2,000/- per month
4.	Civil Judge (Senior Division) (Entry Level) (Rs. 39530-920-40450-1080-49090-1230-54010)	Rs. 15,000/-	Upto Rs. 1,500/- per month

The approval is further subject to the condition as contained at para 2 of Circular No. F. 21/201/GAD/CT/Tel/2967 dated 13.9.2013 issued by the General Administration Department, Govt. of NCT of Delhi that the mobile phone will not ordinarily be replaced within a period of two years from the date of its purchase. However, if at any point of time, the probable cost of repairs exceeds 50% of the total initial cost of the mobile instrument, such a replacement may be allowed.

Further, the earlier approval regarding the mobile phone facility to the rest of the Judicial Officers i.e. Civil Judges (entry level) (except those who are on training during their probation) conveyed vide this office letter No. F.1/80/05-Judl./Suptlaw/695-696 dated 12-09-2012, under which they were entitled to Rs. 10,000/- towards the cost of hand set and a monthly ceiling of Rs. 1500/- towards the rental and call charges, shall also remain in force.

This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department, Government of NCT of Delhi vide U.O No. 01/DS2 dated 04.04.2014.
