Hon'ble High Court vide letter No. 2427/LXXXVII-CPC/e-Courts/Allahabad/ Dated: January 16, 2022 in re: guidelines for functioning of District Courts/ Tribunals keeping in view the status of cases of COVID-19 in District, r/w letter No. 2423/LXXXVII-CPC/e-Courts/Allahabad/ Dated: January 09, 2022 has directed that:-

- 1. The District Judge shall ensure that 50% Judicial Officers of the tota' strength shall attend the Court at a time, on rotation basis.*
- 2. The pregnant lady Judicial Officers/staff, shall be exempted to attend the Court, if necessary, they shall be allowed to work from home.*
- 3. Litigants or other representatives shall be strictly prohibited in the Court premises. However, in urgent cases, with the prior permission of District Judges, the litigants/such persons may be allowed to enter into the Court premises.*

- In compliance of directions of Hon'ble High Court contained in Point No. 1 of the aforementioned guidelines, following arrangements are being made which shall take effect with effect from January 24th, 2022 (Monday) till further orders of Hon'ble Court. It is noteworthy that in previous week, District & Sessions Judge had been sitting throughout the week, however, to avoid continuous exposure in Court room, District & Sessions Judge is also included in roster formulated hereby:-

Learned Judicial Officers shall also undertake the work of their Link officers [provided vide Administrative Order No. 310/2021 and Administrative Order No. 311/2021 dated: 20.09.2021 (Refer Attachment No. 3)] keeping in view that such work falls within the ambit of guidelines of Hon'ble Court enlisted in letter No. 2423 aforesaid. **Further more, the day to day remand duty shall be done by the Junior most Officer assigned the**

Judicial/Administrative work in the aforesaid Roster of the respective Sessions/Special Judge cadre.

Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lucknow shall pass a separate order regarding work-order for the Courts of Magisterial Cadres (which shall include the work distributed to learned Magistrates for remand work on holidays) on rotation basis. Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate shall include himself in roster after his recovery from COVID-19.


- In compliance of directions of Hon'ble High Court contained in Point No. 2 of the aforementioned guidelines, it is hereby directed that the concerned learned Judicial Officers/ Officials of this Judgeship shall move an application addressed to District Judge, Lucknow following which exemptions shall be granted to them in spirit of directions of Hon'ble High Court.
- In compliance of directions of Hon'ble High Court contained in Point No. 3 of aforementioned guidelines, learned O/C Security Committee, District & Sessions Court, Lucknow shall impress upon the Security Incharge/Incharge of the Police Out-Post, District & Sessions Court, Lucknow strictly not to allow the entry of litigants in the premises of District & Sessions Court, Lucknow. In urgent circumstances or in compliance of directions of Court, in case any litigants wishes to enter the District & Sessions Court premises, the person shall address an application to the learned Court concerned which shall pass an order allowing/restricting the entry of the litigant in the premises.

Aforesaid arrangements shall take effect with effect from January 24, 2022 (Monday) till further orders of Hon'ble Court.

Note:-

1. District Judge will be available in his Chamber on those days which are not included in his roster for performing Administrative work.
2. The Additional District Judge/Special Judges shall undertake inspection assigned to them of respective Subordinate Courts irrespective of the fact that they are included in Roster on that day or not.
3. It is hereby directed to all the Judicial Officers/Officials that no one shall leave the station without seeking prior permission in written and shall comply with direction in letter and spirit.
4. No officer of Civil Judge (Junior Division) or Civil Judge (Senior Division) holding charge of Institutional Court shall proceed on leave or will post any leave/station leave application on e-Services Portal without prior permission of District Judge.
5. Stenographers of learned Presiding Officers on the day where the Presiding Officer is excluded from roster shall report to Administrative Office without fail so that their services may be taken as per necessity.
6. The Presiding Officers of the Courts are expected to pass the order(s) and judgment(s) already reserved on the date fixed

irrespective of the fact that they are assigned the work-order in Roster or not on that day.

Sir/ Madam,

In addition to the earlier guidelines/ directions on the subject noted above, I am directed to communicate the following directions of Hon'ble Court -

1. The District Judge shall ensure that 50% Judicial Officers of the total strength shall attend the Court at a time, on rotation basis.

2. The pregnant lady Judicial Officers/ staff, shall be exempted to attend the Court. If necessary, they shall be allowed to work from home.

3. Litigants or other representatives shall be strictly prohibited in the Court premises. However, in urgent cases, with the prior permission of District Judges, the litigants/such persons may be allowed to enter into the Court Premises.

The above guidelines shall be effective from January 17, 2022, till further orders.

It is requested to take necessary steps at your end to ensure the compliance of the directions given by Hon'ble Court. It is also requested to the District Judges of concerned district that the above directions may be communicated to the Presiding Officers of the other Courts/ Tribunals subordinate to the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad, for ensuring compliance in your district.

Subject : Guidelines for functioning of District Courts/Tribunals, keeping in view of the status of the cases of COVID-19 in the Districts.

Sir/Madam,

I have been directed by the Hon'ble Court to communicate that due to recent increase in the cases of COVID-19, the following guidelines, **in addition to the guidelines issued earlier**, shall be applicable to all the Courts (including Tribunals) subordinate to the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad.

1. That before opening of campus, District Judges will ensure complete sanitization (strictly as per medical guidelines) and cleaning of entire court campus on daily basis by way of seeking assistance from the District Magistrate and Chief Medical Officer of the concerned district.
2. That all the Courts and Tribunals subordinate to High Court of Judicature at Allahabad will take up following matters –
 - a) Admission of new / pending matter (if any).
 - b) Bail (Pending / Fresh).
 - c) Anticipatory Bail (Pending / Fresh).
 - d) Matters involving release of vehicle, disposal of petty offence cases.
 - e) Urgent injunction matters (Pending / Fresh).
 - f) Matter related to receiving and disposal of police report under Section 173 Cr.P.C.

- g) Disposal of Applications of Investigating Officer such as matter involving NBW, process under Section 82/83 Cr.P.C., Statements under Section 164 Cr.P.C.
 - h) Remand / Other Judicial Work in respect of Under-Trial Prisoner will be done strictly through Video-Conferencing only. In case of any technical issue, other modes may be adopted.
 - i) The cases in which the evidence is complete, the arguments can be heard virtually or written submissions can be entertained.
 - j) Delivery of pending Orders / Judgment, if any, if the arguments have already been completed.
 - k) Pending office work.
 - l) Any other Urgent Judicial work.
 - m) Any other Administrative work.
3. That in Criminal Cases, no adverse order will be passed / no coercive action will be taken, in absence of concerned parties.
 4. That if the District Magistrate / Chief Medical Officer of a concerned district is of the opinion that the District / Outlying Court Campus should be closed for a particular period due to COVID-19, the then District Court / Outlying Court may be closed for the said period.
 5. That all intimation mentioning the specific reasons will be sent to Allahabad High Court.
 6. That immediate after completion of the work, the Judicial Officers and the Court Staff will leave the Court premises.
 7. That the District Judge will ensure minimal entry of Court Staff in Court premises. The District Judge will exercise discretion in deciding number of Staff, assigning duty by way of rotation, fixing days on weekly basis and time-slots.
 8. Wearing of Gown is exempted till further orders.

The above modalities & arrangements shall be effective w.e.f. January 10, 2022.

The concerned Bar Associations may be informed accordingly.
