F.23/Misc/Covid-19/DGHS/NHC/2020/Pt XXI/201-208 dated 24.04.2021 and order no. 01/H&FW/Covid-Cell/2020/07/238-249 dated 14.04.2021 (Copies attached).

The entry of the aforesaid CHC shall be only from Gate No. 2 of Delhi Judicial Academy, Dwarka, New Delhi.

1. In view of the rising number of COVID cases and in order to augment COVID hospital bed capacity, the following hotels, to be requisitioned by the District Magistrates as per details provided by them, are linked to the hospitals mentioned against their names for converting them into extended COVID Hospitals, wherein, the medical services shall be provided by the linked COVID private hospitals as per **Annexure I**.
2. The linked private hospital shall admit COVID-19 Positive patients in their extended COVID Hospital as per the patients' medical condition and in case such patients turn severe at any point of time during their stay in the hotel, he/she shall be transferred/admitted in the linked private hospitals at its scheduled rates.
3. The linked private hospital is required to provide sufficient manpower (Nurses Doctors, etc.) as per norms. Further, the linked hospitals are also required to provide oxygen supply, either in the form of oxygen concentrator or oxygen cylinder, in the extended COVID hospital in case patient requires oxygen support. The linked hospitals shall provide all consumables like PPE kits, N-95 Masks, gloves, medicines and equipment like Pulse-oximeter, thermometer, concentrator/cylinder, etc. They shall also make necessary arrangements to provide resuscitation services (equipment, drugs & medical consumables) in the extended COVID hospitals in case there is a deterioration in the clinical condition of the patient.
4. The linked private hospitals are required to take over hotel indicated against their name phase-wise as requisitioned by concerned District Magistrate, Government of NCT of Delhi under DDMA. The hotel shall provide regular hotel services including rooms, housekeeping, disinfection & food for the patients etc. at a price not greater than Rs. 5000/- for Five star Hotel and Rs. 4000/- for Four/Three star hotel per day per person. The rates for Banquet Halls will be provided by Divisional Commissioner in due course.
5. The linked hospital shall be paid an amount, not greater than Rs. 5000/- per patient per day for their medical services to COVID-19 patients inclusive of all consumables, services of doctors, nurses, paramedical staff and nursing staff etc. as per the norms.
6. However, investigation charges, if any, shall be charged by the linked hospital at their scheduled rates and for oxygen support the linked hospital is allowed to charge at the hotel @ Rs.2000/- per day basis. The medical services

provided by the linked hospital at their facility shall be charged at their respectively schedule rates.

7. All charges shall be collected by the linked Hospital and the linked hospital shall make payment to the hotel etc.
8. Further, the linked hospital may accommodate their doctors and staff at the hotel at their own expense, if required.
9. This issues with the approval of Hon'ble Minister (Health), GNCTD.




ORDER

Hotels, requisitioned by the District Magistrates, were linked to private hospitals and were converted into extended COVID Hospitals, wherein, the medical services would be provided by the linked COVID private hospitals vide Order No. 01/H&FW/COVID-Cell/2020/07/238-249 dated 14.04.2021 issued by Secretary (H&FW), GNCTD.

The said order mentioned as under:

"The linked private hospital shall admit COVID-19 positive patients in their extended COVID Hospital as per the patients' medical condition and in case such patients turn severe at any point of time during the stay in the hotel, he/she shall be transferred/ admitted in the linked private hospitals at its schedule rates. Further, the linked private hospitals were required to provide sufficient manpower (nurses, doctors, etc.) as per norms. Furthermore, the linked hospitals are also required to provide oxygen supply, either in the form of oxygen concentrator or oxygen cylinder, in the extended COVID hospital in case the patient requires oxygen support. The linked hospitals shall provide all consumables like PPE Kits, N-95 Masks, gloves, medicines and equipments like Pulse-oximeter, thermometer, concentrator/cylinder, etc. They shall also make necessary arrangements to provide resuscitation services (equipment, drugs & medical consumables) in the extended COVID hospitals in case there is deterioration in the clinical condition of the patient. The linked hospital shall be paid an amount, not greater than Rs. 5,000/- per patient per day for their medical services to COVID-19 patients inclusive of all consumables, services of doctors, nurses, paramedical staff and nursing staff etc. as per the norms. However, investigation charges, if any, shall be charged by the linked hospital at their schedule rates and for oxygen support the linked hospital is allowed to charge at the rate of Rs. 2000/- per day basis. The medical services provided by the linked hospital at their facility shall be charged at their respective scheduled rates."

A meeting regarding "Timely medical assistance to the staff of High Court" was held on 24.04.2021 at 3.00 PM under the Chairpersonship of Justice Mukta Gupta along with Justice Navin Chawla, Justice Pratibha M. Singh, Sh. Manoj Jain (Registrar General) and senior officers of Government of NCT of Delhi wherein it was decided that Delhi Judicial Academy, Sector-14, Dwarka shall be linked with Venkateshwar Hospital, Dwarka and converted into extended COVID hospital for judicial officers & court staff on the same terms and conditions as mentioned in Order No. 01/H&FW/COVID-Cell/2020/07/238-249 dated 14.04.2021.


