



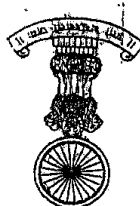

Sub: Correct data of pending cases.
May 30, 2017

Dear Chief Justice,

The other day I was quite surprised to find that in a court complex while there are only about 3,000 cases actually pending, the computer entries showed a pendency of about 17,000 cases. This indicates that the data of cases disposed of was not entered in the computer, leading to this serious error.

This is to request you to kindly ensure that there is a physical verification of the actual pendency of cases in all the District Courts as well as in the High Court and necessary corrections made in the computer. The entries will, of course, have to be made on a regular basis so that the correct pendency of cases is reflected.

In addition to the above, it will be necessary to carry out a similar exercise with regard to identification of cases that are more than 10 years old. I have found that the year of institution of a case is sometimes not correctly reflected and cases are shown pending for more than 1,000 years. In one instance, the case was shown as pending for 1,800 years (instead of 2012 the entry was 202).

The above exercise is necessary so that incorrect information is not disseminated. A time limit may be fixed for completing the exercise which, I am sure, can be completed in about one month's time.
