1	for reconsideration of his application for allotment of chamber. He has stated that one of his documents contain 2 signature, one of his and another of his wife.	Committee has noticed that during the "Subsequent Allotment" process eligibility of Shri Neeraj P. Singh, advocate could not established due to non-filing of sufficient documents to support his claim of being "main counsel" in 15 court cases of South & South East District. Status of documents filed by applicant lawyers is 14 Cases & 1 Vakalatnama with multiple signature. He has filed a representation earlier also which was rejected by committee vide MoM dated 27.11.2017 after due re-scrutiny by a Sub Committee.
		Now, the plea of the applicant is that his representation be considered on similar criteria as adopted in accepting the plea of Sh. Narendra Kumar and Ms. Vasundhara, Advocates that their vakalatnama were signed by husbandwife. The said vakalatnama were treated as valid document to establish applicant lawyer as "main counsel" in the particular case (s). The vakalatnama invalidated by LCAC has been stated to have actually signed by husband-wife i.e. he & his spouse who is also a lawyer.
		After due deliberation, Committee is of unanimous view to get the documents re-examined by the Ld. ACJ (S) on above plea of applicant lawyer.
2	A representation dated 16.01.2019 has been received from Sh. Phool Singh, Advocate for allotment of chamber.	The applicant lawyers had applied for chamber in "Subsequent Allotment" phase vide application no. 0229 and found ineligible by this committee. Status of documents submitted by him was 12 Cases & 1 Vakalatnama.
		The committee noticed that all the applicant lawyers were given an opportunity to submit their representation till 18.10.2017. The present applicant didn't avail the same.

Taking a lenient view Committee is of unanimous view that before proceeding further, documents furnished by the applicant lawyer be re-scrutinized by the Ld. ACJ (S). 3 A representation dated 02.02.2019 has Sh. Sanjeev Sabharwal was applicant in "Initial Allotment" Phase. Hon'ble High court in its received from Sh. Sanjeev order dated 29.04.2014 directed to consider Sabharwal, Advocate for allotment of the allotment of chamber to Sh. Sanjeev Sabharwal chamber on basis of representation made by him dated in forthcoming round (Subsequent Allotment). 12.02.2016 as per the order dated Applicant applied in Subsequent Allotment vide 29.04.2014 passed in Writ Petition(Civil) application no. 00624. On scrutiny of documents No. 1350/2014. he was found ineligible being status of documents as 14 Cases & 03 Vakalatnamas (with multiple signatures). Committee is of unanimous view that before proceeding further in the matter, documents be rescrutinized by the Ld. ACJ (S). I) <u>Double Occupancy Chambers</u> I) In compliance of Minutes of Meeting dated Ch. No. 357 (1st Slot) 27.02.2020, the office has issued notices to next Ch. No. 479 (2nd Slot) six seniors namely Sh. Rajesh Kumar Singh, Sh. Applications received Sunil Kumar, Nirmala Devi, Sh. Sushil Kumar for (Double Occupancy Chamber) from Kohli, Sh. Surat Singh Yadav and Ms. Nitika 1. Sh. Surat Singh Yadav dtd. Mangla out of the list of eligible applicant 11.12.2020. lawyers of "Initial Allotment" phase. In Sh. Sushil Kohli dtd. Kumar response thereof, applications are received from 08.10.2020. three lawyers named as Sh. Surat Singh Yadav, dtd. 3. Sh. Rajesh Kumar Singh Sh. Sushil Kumar Kohli and Sh. Rajesh Kumar 19.03.2020. Singh. Scrutiny of documents is required to be done by LCAC. Committee considered the applications and is of unanimous view that before proceeding further, documents furnished by the applicant lawyers be scrutinized by both the ACJs. II) LCAC vide notice dated 13.03.2020 invited II) Single Occupancy Chambers for applications from the allottees of the Double Up-gradation of chamber from Double Occupancy Chambers (Initial Allotment) for Occupancy to Single Occupancy upgradation of their chambers to Single Vacant Chambers:-Ch. No. 772 (Single Occupancy) Occupancy Chambers. In response thereof, only Ch. No. 874 (Single Occupancy) two applications were received, one is from Sh. Naresh Kumar, Advocate and another is from Ch. No. 823 (Single Occupancy) Ms. Archana Gupta, Advocate. The Committee vide MoM dated 02.03.2021 observed that due to Applications received in response to notice dated 06.03.02021 :-COVID-19 Pandemic, most of the lawyers may be unaware of this notice and resolved to issue 1. Sh. Devinder Singh Tokas dtd. fresh notice. Accordingly, fresh notice dated 23.03.2021 (NDBA No. 1048) 06.03.2021 was issued. Jagat Singh Baasta dtd. 24.03.2021(NDBA No. 1092) Now after issuance of fresh notice dated 06.03.2021, six applications have been received 3. Ms. Archana Gupta dtd. 19.03.2021 against three vacant chambers. Applicant at sl. (NDBA No. 1290) no. 6 i.e. Sh. Ashok Kumar Kotnala, Advocate 4. Ms. Anita Sharoha dtd. 24.03.2021 who filed his representation after due date i.e. (NDBA No. 2544-A) 5. Sh. Abdus Samad dtd. 12.03.2021 26.03.2021, is an allottee of Double Occupancy Chamber in Subsequent Allotment phase. As (NDBA No. 3017) such he is not entitled for above said allotment/ 6. Sh. Ashok Kumar Kotnala dtd. 26.03.2021 (received on 31.03.2021) an upgradation. His application is unanimously

Committee perused the seniority status of applicants at sl. no. 1 to 5 as per their NDBA Membership enrollment and their requests are considered. Sh. Devinder Singh Tokas (NDBA Seniority No. 1048), Sh. Jagat Singh Baasta (NDBA Seniority No. 1092) & Ms. Archana Gupta (NDBA Seniority No. 1290) being the most amongst the said representationists, their request is allowed. Thus Sh. Devinder Singh Tokas is allotted chamber no. 772 (on single occupancy basis) in lieu of 1st slot of chamber no. 224 (on double occupancy basis) earlier allotted to him , Sh. Jagat Singh Baasta is allotted chamber no. 823 (on single occupancy basis) in lieu of 1st slot of chamber no. 103 (on double occupancy basis) earlier allotted to him and Ms. Archana Gupta is allotted chamber no. 874 (on single occupancy basis) in lieu of 1st slot of chamber no. 308 (on double occupancy basis) earlier allotted to her. Subject to following conditions:-(i) the allotment of space in the chamber earlier made in their favour stands cancelled. (ii) the vacant possession of the space in the chamber earlier allotted shall be surrendered within 07 days clearing all up-to-date dues; and (iii) after compliance with condition no. (ii) above, the possession of the chamber now allotted shall be taken over making all necessary payments within 15 days. The representation of other advocates to above effect were, thus, filed. Subject to compliance with conditions of above upgradation, 1st slot in chamber no. 224, ch. no. 103 & ch. no. 308 on double occupancy basis additionally shall become available allotment. The Branch In-charge, is directed to mention this vacancy when cases come up for consideration on allotments. 5 Matter is considered and discussed with the (a) Request of Sh.
