It is observed from the record that the directions of Hon'ble Court have duly been complied with. The applicant was informed about the decision dated 27.11.2017 of this Committee vide office letter dated 12.12.2017.</p> <p>His subsequent Writ Petition No. 865/2018 was disposed off vide combined order dated 28.03.2019 with the orders that "the petitioner in W.P. (civil) 865/2018 has also now produced certified copies of order sheets to establish that the petitioner was the main counsel in cases in respect of which vakalatnama have been submitted. However, the said documents cannot be considered at this belated stage. Admittedly, the said documents were not provided at the initial stage and were not provided even along with the representations made by the petitioner.</p>
