His father stated to had suffered with sudden paralytic attack and consequently, he lost his ability to communicate effectively with the authorities like BSES and Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, in the matters relating to his allotted Chamber/ slot in said complex.
		Chamber no. 155 (Single Occupancy) in this Court Complex has been stated to be secured on surrender of Chamber no. 161 at Patiala House Court complex, in the year 2011. In respect of above, it is noticed that although the application of rule "One Chamber One Lawyer" wasn't in force at the time of allotment of Chamber no. 155 in favour of Advocate herein, it is imperative to mention that said principal of "One Chamber One Lawyer" has since been implemented with the directions of Hon'ble High Court passed vide it's judgment/ order dated 10.02.2017 in case titled as P.K. Dash & ors Vs. Bar Council of Delhi etc.
		Advocate/applicant herein in his reply has further submitted that presently, in terms of approval dated 08.04.2019 of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, half share in Chamber no. 171, Block II, Lawyers' Block in the court complex of Hon'ble High Court of Delhi is being hold jointly by him and his nephew Sh. Sheen Sherawat, Advocate, after the demise of his father Sh. B.S. Sherawat, Advocate and he has now intended to surrender his share in said Chamber in the name of his nephew Sh.
