Apropos to above, Hon'ble Minister of State (I/C) for Law & Justice and Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs and Culture, Government of India has expressed that taking the gains of Phase-I and Phase II to the next level, eCourts Phase III aims to usher in a regime of maximum ease of Justice by moving towards digital, online and paperless courts through digitization of the entire court records including legacy records and by bringing in universalization of e-Filing/ e-Payments through saturation of all court complexes with e-Sewa Kendras.

It has been emphasized the Government has invested an immense amount of funds in developing the IT and VC infrastructure in Courts, so that the benefits of e-initiatives can percolate to the masses and deterrents like high cost and traveling long distance can be mitigated for the common man and we can truly move to a phase of "Justice to all".

VC equipments alongwith dedicated internet facility and VC software have been made available in 1344 Courts of Rajasthan. VC Rules 2020 have been framed and enforced w.e.f. 02.08.2021. Likewise E-Filing 3.0 has been implemented. E-Payment facility of court fee and fine is also available which is integrated with eGRAS of the State Government.
