**CIRCULAR**

In terms of the directions contained in letter no. 4442-4453/DHC/Gaz/G-2/SC-Judgment/2023 dated 24.05.2023, received from the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi, New Delhi and due deliberations held in the meeting held on 30.05.2023 on the subject matter, it is hereby impressed upon all Judicial Officers, exercising criminal jurisdiction at South-West District, Dwarka Courts, New Delhi as under:

1. That all the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter of "Satender Kumar Antil vs. Central Bureau of Investigation" and in all other related cases, be strictly and scrupulously complied with.
2. That monthly report regarding compliance of the directions issued by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the aforesaid matters be submitted in the following formats, duly signed by the concerned Judicial Officer, after personally cross-checking the same to ensure that there are no errors:
