Respected Sir/Madam,

Refer to the ibid subject and the letter dated 12.02.2025 of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Yashwant Varma, Judge-High Court of Delhi and Chairman of the IT & Al Committee, High Court of Delhi conveying thereby that the Delhi District Courts have initiated a large-scale digitization project to digitize records spanning approximately three centuries and the contract has already been awarded for the digitization and scanning of around 50 crore pages. This initiative represents a monumental step toward modernizing the judicial system, enhancing record management, and ensuring better accessibility and transparency.

It has also been communicated that timely completion of this project is critical for improving access to justice, preserving court records and achieving the intended outcomes. To ensure its success, the vendor engaged for the project has been instructed to scan a minimum of 2 lakh pages per day, per court complex, including Dheerpur Record Room. This necessitates the digitization of 16 lakh pages daily to meet the overall target. The project is designed to transform how records are managed and delivered, reducing the burden of physical records and providing greater efficiency and accessibility to all stakeholders.

In order to complete this massive task effectively and in a timely manner, your cooperation is vital. This collaborative effort will not only help meet the ambitious goals of this project but also set a benchmark for other jurisdictions. It will ensure that the Delhi District Judiciary remains at the forefront of the Hon'ble Chief Justice of India's initiative to transform the judicial system.

I would like to bring to your attention that as per information received from your district, the adequate physical space to the service provider has already been identified and provided. Additionally, the necessary electrical supply and local network infrastructure have been established, and the required digitization equipment has been installed.

The concerned Ld. Officer In-charges of Record Rooms & Digitization Cell and staff of Digitization Cell/Record Rooms of all districts/court complex have been briefed regarding the new project and their responsibilities. Training has also been imparted to all relevant officials posted in the Record Rooms (Sessions, Criminal, and Civil) and the Digitization Cells across all districts and court complexes.

Needless to say, a virtual meeting was held under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Yashwant Varma with the Ld. Principal District & Sessions Judges of all

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districts, Worthy Registrar General, Worthy Registrar (Vigilance) and Ld. CPC of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi. During this meeting, it was emphasized that committees should be constituted in each district to monitor the progress of the digitization project and ensure adherence to the set timelines. These committees will also be required to submit fortnightly reports pertaining to the respective districts to the Ld. Chairman of IT & Digitization, Delhi District Courts.

A PowerPoint presentation detailing the Digitization Project, including a workflow chart and the steps to be taken by the office and service provider has already been shared through email, as directed by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Yashwant Varma, Judge-High Court of Delhi and Chairman of the IT & Al Committee, High Court of Delhi.

In compliance to the above directions, I kindly request your good self to constitute a committee as approved by the Hon'ble Principal District & Sessions Judge (HQs):
