

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE LAWYER'S CHAMBERS ALLOTMENT COMMITTEE, SAKET COURTS HELD ON 03.10.2018 IN THE CONFERENCE HALL, 3rd FLOOR, SAKET COURT COMPLEX, NEW DELHI.

Both the Administrative Civil Judge(s) of South & South-East District(s) are stated to be on leave.

A. Representation for allotment of Chamber:-

1. Writ Petition filed by Sh. Pawan Kumar Jha along with his representation dated 16.02.2018 for allotment of chamber.

The Writ Petition was treated as the representation of Sh. Pawan Kumar Jha. He was also heard in person.

Sh. Pawan Kumar Jha was shown his file and he conceded that he had submitted 05 (five) Vakalatnamas bearing multiple signatures. It may be mentioned herein that as the Committee had found that none of the applicants submitted certified copies of 15 (fifteen) cases reflecting their appearances by name in orders/judgments/statement of court cases as per the requirement at the time of inviting of applications for allotment of chamber between 23.06.2014 to 07.07.2014 extended till 30.08.2014. A Sub-Committee appointed for scrutinizing the applications set the criteria for drawing up the seniority list as "cases" and "vakalatnamas", the latter being vakalatnamas signed by multiple lawyers. This was accepted by the Committee vide minutes of meeting held on 05.09.2017. These criteria has been upheld by the Hon'ble High Court.

The Hon'ble High Court in W.P. (C) 1246/2018 titled as "Vinod Kumar Vs. Lawyers Chambers Allotment Committee & Ors." & W.P. (C) No.1250/2018 titled as "Dharmendra Singh Vs. Lawyers Chambers Allotment Committee" vide its order dated 09.02.2018 found no infirmity in the above criteria adopted by Lawyers Chambers Committee for scrutiny of the candidature of applicant lawyers.

The representation of Sh. Pawan Kumar Jha dated 20.09.2017 was considered in the light of these criteria and it was found that he had 11 clear cases but had filed 05 vakalatnamas bearing multiple signatures. Therefore, he was found ineligible, even on rescrutiny by the Committee. Hence his representation dated 20.09.2017 was rejected. Even during the personal hearing given to Sh. Pawan Kumar Jha today, the Ld. Advocate was not able to point out in the documents submitted by him any errors in the consideration of his documents as

per the eligibility criteria. Since the seniority list has been drawn up by simultaneous satisfaction of eligibility criteria, seniority in SBA including enrollment in BCD, the request of the Ld. advocate for inclusion only on the basis of seniority in the SBA as founder member or BCD cannot be acceded to.

For these reasons, representation of Sh. Pawan Kumar Jha dated 20.09.2017 as well as the representation of the Ld. advocate based on in WP (C) 1056/2018 which he had filed in the Hon'ble High Court is rejected by the Committee unanimously. He is informed accordingly. Copy of this resolution be also sent to Sh. Pawan Kumar Jha.

2. Order passed by Hon'ble High Court of Delhi in the Writ Petition (C) No.366/2018 titled as Sh. Ajay Kumar Vs. Lawyers Chamber Allotment Committee.

The office has put up the order dated 20.08.2018 of the Hon'ble High Court whereby the matter was remanded back to the Allotment Committee to consider the petitioner's representation afresh.

In view of the order of the Hon'ble High Court, the matter is reconsidered and the representation of Sh. Ajay Kumar is accepted unanimously. Office is directed to place him according to his seniority in the list of eligible applicant lawyers and process the case for further action.

3. Representation dated 24.01.2018 of Sh. Vijay Pal Bidhuri requesting to allot him the chamber as given to Sh. Karamveer Singh.

It is observed by the Committee that the representation dated 24.01.2018 of Sh. Vijay Pal Bidhuri has been deferred in the meetings held on 09.03.2018 & 16.05.2018 and has been taken for consideration in this meeting.

The Committee gone through the representation dated 24.01.2018 made by the applicant whereby he submitted that it was on account of the fact that his mother was admitted at Rockland Hospital that he could not remove the objection that were reflected against his name and published at the time of Initial Allotment. He learnt about the objections through RTI on 16.01.2018. It is further submitted that the only objection is that he had not enclosed the SBA certificate whereas his Membership No. is V-160. The applicant submitted that on account of illness of his mother, he could not verify the SBA membership certificate. He also submitted that he had surrendered his chamber at the Patiala House Court in the hope that he would be allotted a chamber in the Saket Court and also enclosed the Surrender Certificate.

The office has reported that applicant has applied for allotment of chamber in the process of Initial Allotment in 2011 and was placed at S.No.00191 in the list C-1 of tentative eligible applicants. Further, vide minutes of meeting held on 18.05.2012, applicant was included in List D-7 at S.No.00078 being found

provisionally eligible for allotment of chamber in Initial Phase of allotment and was offered allotment of chamber on Double Occupancy basis through office notice dated 18.05.2012. It is further reported that applicant Sh. Vijay Pal Bidhuri did not submit the required documents for acceptance and therefore, the allotment of the applicant stood forfeited vide minutes of meeting dated 21.08.2012.

The President and Secretary, Saket Bar Association confirmed the SBA membership of Sh. Vijay Pal Bidhuri as correct.

In view of the fact that applicant was included in List D-7, it is apparent that he was found eligible for the first Initial Process of allotment. Having a practice in Saket Court, he would not have rejected the offer of allotment of chamber in Saket and also surrender his chamber at Patiala House Courts. He has explained that he was unable to present the SBA Certificate on time due to the illness of his mother. It was not a document that was not available to him as admittedly at the time of first allotment, he was found to have fulfilled the eligibility criteria including SBA Membership.

On these exceptional circumstances, the matter is reconsidered. The Committee unanimously resolves to allow the representation of Sh. Vijay Pal Bidhuri. It is also unanimously resolved that 1st slot in chamber No.437 under Double Occupancy basis under Initial Allotment be allotted to Sh. Vijay Pal Bidhuri. Office is directed to take further necessary action in this regard. Accordingly, **List E- 32 (Initial Allotment)** has been prepared and same be published as per past practice

4. Representation dated 01.06.2018 of Ms. Anuradha, Advocate with request to consider her submissions as considered in the case of Sh. Narender Kumar Verma & Vasundhra vide minutes of meeting dated 27.11.2017.

The representation of Ms. Anuradha, Advocate was discussed and it was unanimously resolved that Ld. Administrative Civil Judge (South)/Member Secretary will scrutinize the application of Ms. Anuradha and submit a report to this Committee.

5. Undated representation received on 19.06.2018 from Sh. Vipin K Singh, Advocate for recalling the order of rejection of allotment of chamber.

The office has reported that Sh. Vipin K Singh, Advocate was found eligible for allotment of chamber and he was provisionally offered chamber vide List D-21 published vide minutes of meeting held on 06.12.2017. It is further informed by the Office that no individual was informed about the allotment as the same was uploaded on the website and was also affixed on the Notice Board of the Lawyer's Chambers Block by the Saket Bar Association. No response was received from Sh.

Vipin Kumar Singh within the prescribed time limit and thus his candidature stood rejected by the Committee vide minutes of meeting held on 16.01.2018.

In view of the above, the Committee unanimously resolved that there is no ground to accept the representation of Sh. Vipin K. Singh and hence his representation is unanimously rejected. He be informed accordingly.

6. Representation of Sh. Radhey Shyam Aggarwal, Advocate to reconsider his application for allotment of chamber.

The representation of Sh. Radhey Shyam Aggarwal, Advocate was considered and it was found that the applicant does not fulfill the eligibility criteria.

Hence it is unanimously resolved to decline the representation of Sh Radhey Shyam Aggarwal, Advocate. He be informed accordingly.

7. Representation dated 06.04.2018 of Ms. Garima Singh, Advocate to allot her chamber.

The representation of Ms. Garima Singh, Advocate was considered and it was found that the applicant has not applied for chamber during the Initial or Subsequent Allotment process. Hence it is unanimously resolved to decline the representation of Ms. Garima Singh, Advocate. She be informed accordingly.

8. Representation of Sh. Mansha Ram Singh, Advocate for allotment of chamber.

The office has reported that the applicant is at S.No.114 of the Eligible Lawyer List and the allotment of chamber of Double Occupancy basis have been considered upto S.No.112.

It is unanimously resolved that representation of Sh. Mansha Ram Singh will be considered as per availability of slots in chambers of Multiple Occupancy basis.

9. Representation of Sh. Kausar Akhtar Khan, Advocate for allotment of chamber.

It is reported by the Office that Civil Suit filed by the applicant lawyer along with Sh. Bijay Kumar for allotment of chamber is pending consideration in the Court of Ms. Mona Tardi Kerketta, Ld. JSCC-ASCJ, South District, Saket Court.

The office is directed to submit the report of present status of Civil Suit. Matter is deferred.

B. Change of Chamber:-

10. Representation dated 26.05.2018 of Sh. Satyevir Singh Grewal, Advocate for change of chamber from 112 to 186.

It is informed by the office that applicant was allotted 2nd slot in Chamber No.112 under the category reserved for Physically Challenged Advocates and now

applicant is willing to change his chamber from 112 to 186.

It is reported by the office that 2nd slot in Chamber No.186 is vacant and available for allotment. Therefore, it is unanimously resolved to allot 2nd slot of Chamber No.186 to Sh. Satyevir Singh Grewal, Advocate on double occupancy basis under the category reserved for Physically Challenged Advocates. Accordingly **List GG-8** has been prepared and the same be published as per past practice.

11. Representation dated 04.06.2018 of Sh. Suresh Kumar Batham, Advocate for changing of his chamber from Chamber No.270 to Chamber No.101.

Since the office has reported that the Chamber No.101 is reserved for the Retired Judicial Officers, the representation of Suresh Kumar Batham, Advocate is unanimously rejected

12. Representation dated 18.08.2018 of Sh. Noor-ul-Islam, Advocate, allottee of Chamber No.507 to change his chamber either to Chamber No.437 or 671.

Since the office has reported that 1st slot of Chamber No.671 is available for allotment, it is unanimously resolved that the request of Sh. Noor-ul-Islam for change of chamber is accepted and it is further resolved that the 1st slot of Chamber No.671 be allotted to Sh. Noor-ul-Islam, Advocate.

Accordingly, his name be incorporated in **List E-32 (Initial Allotment)** and same be published as per past practice.

C. Application for Allotment:-

13. Initial Allotment.

It is observed by the Committee that in the meeting held on 16.05.2018, vacancy of 02 slots of Initial Allotment was observed and the office was directed to inform the next six senior most persons as reflected in List C-1 (under Initial Allotment) to submit the application as per format along with requisite documents and to place the same for further decision before the Committee.

It is reported by the Office that letters of offer were sent to Sh. Yogesh Sharma, Sh. Rajiv Sharma, Ms. Nirmala Devi, Ms. Nitika Mangla, Sh. Surat Singh Yadav and Sh. Sushil Kumar Kohli and response of all the applicants have been received. The office report is that the documents are proper and the applications of Sh. Yogesh Sharma and Sh. Rajiv Sharma are accepted as per their seniority.

Since Sh. Yogesh Sharma has opted to be allotted first slot in Chamber No.711 with Ms. Vandana Kehlon, who has given her consent, it is unanimously resolved to allot chamber No.711 to Sh. Yogesh Sharma.

Accordingly he may be offered first slot in Chamber No.711 and **List D-26**

(Initial Allotment) is prepared and same be published as per past practice.

In regard to Sh. Rajiv Sharma, the second senior most advocates in the abovesaid, the matter is deferred in view of resolution of Item No.3 of these minutes.

14. Fresh application for allotment of chamber to Sh. Harnam Singh Sharma under Rule 8(ii) (Category Reserved for Retired Judicial Officer)

Deferred.

15(A). Application of Sh. Hira Lal Jha, Advocate for allotment of chamber under category reserved for Physically Challenged Persons.

15(B). Application of Sh. Bhupendra Chaturvedi, Advocate for allotment of chamber under category reserved for Physically Challenged Persons.

Sh. Hira Lal Jha, Advocate has appeared in person. His matter has been deferred for want of Disability Certificate from Govt. Hospital in Delhi.

The office is directed to inform both the applicants to submit the Disability Certificate, under the Persons With Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 from the Competent Board of the Govt. Hospitals in Delhi.

16. Representation of Sh. Rajeev Nandan Singh, Advocate for reconsideration of his application regarding allotment of chamber.

It is observed by the Committee that in the minutes of meeting held on 16.05.2018 it was noted that the disability certificate of Sh. Rajeev Nandan Singh, Advocate did not record permanent disability. Hence his application was found ineligible to be considered under the reserved category for Physically Challenged Persons. There is no ground made out for reconsideration as no new fact is disclosed. Hence, the application of Sh. Rajeev Nandan Singh is unanimously rejected.

D. Allotment after offer:-

17. Under Initial Allotment.

It is noticed by the Committee that vide minutes of meeting held on 16.05.2018, Sh. Siddhartha Mohan was offered allotment of chamber vide List D-24 (Initial Allotment). He has accepted the same.

It is unanimously resolved that 2nd slot in Chamber No.848 be allotted to Sh. Siddhartha Mohan. Accordingly his name be incorporated in **List E-32 (Initial Allotment)** and same be published as per past practice.

18. Under Subsequent Allotment.

It is noticed by the Committee that vide minutes of meeting held on 16.05.2018, Ms. Jaya Goyal and Mohd. Shakeel Khan were offered allotment of chamber vide List D-25 (Subsequent Allotment). Both the advocates have accepted the same and Ms. Jaya Goyal has preferred allotment of slot in Chamber No.780 and Mohd. Shakeel Khan has preferred a slot in chamber No. 848.

It is unanimously resolved that 2nd slot in Chamber No.780 be allotted to Ms. Jaya Goyal and since slot Chamber No.848 has already been allotted to Sh. Siddhartha Mohan, it is unanimously resolved to allot 2nd slot in chamber No.507 to Mohd. Shakeel Khan, which would be vacated by Sh. Noor-ul-Islam vide Agenda item No. 12 of these minutes.

Accordingly **List E-33 (Subsequent Allotment)** be prepared and same be published as per past practice.

E. Allotment in Multiple Occupancy Chambers:-

19. Joint Representation of three advocates namely Sh. Rizwan Ali, Sh. Manoj Bhati & Sh. Arun Kumar for seeking conversion in cubicle of remaining space measuring 8X6 ft. available in 14 halls into 14 cubical considering the needs of practicing lawyers/applicant.

Since the cubicles are being constructed as per the drawing and layouts suggested by the Consultant Architect as per optimal use of space, the representation is unanimously declined.

20. Joint representation of 06 Advocates namely Sh. Amitabh Singh, Sh. Pankaj Kumar Singh, Sh. Mukesh Kumar Chuhan, Sh. Rabindra Tiwary, Sh. Rajeev Kumar and Sh. Ajay Kumar Rai regarding joint allotment of seats in one multiple occupancy chamber.

21. Joint letter of 06 Advocates namely Sh. Sumit Khari, Sh. Shyam Babu, Sh. Pradeep Kumar, Sh. Ajay Sharma, Sh. Pea Pankaj and Sh. Vinod Charan with a request to allot them a multiple occupancy chamber jointly.

22. Consideration on allotment under Multiple Occupancy basis.

The office is directed to draw up a tentative list of advocates who would be covered as per their seniority in the seniority list already drawn up as per minutes of meeting held on 27.11.2017 for allotment of multiple occupancy chambers to be considered in the next meeting.

F. Non-payment of Dues:-

23. Representation dated 15.11.2017 of Sh. Wahid Hussain, Advocate,

Allottee of Chamber No.623 restoration of chamber.

24. Representation of Sh. Ram Baboo Sisodia and Sh. Ram Chandra Sisodia, Allottees of Chamber No.259 for restoration of chamber.

25. Representation of Sh. Anil Kumar, Advocates allottee of Chamber No.561.

It is reported by the Office that all the abovesaid Advocates have paid their dues of Licence Fee and Maintenance Charges.

It is noted that the allotment of chambers to these Advocates were cancelled due to non payment of dues. As per the office report, they have paid their dues. It is unanimously resolved that the chambers be restored to these advocates with the direction to allottees to ensure timely payment of dues in future.

26. Representation of Mohd. Sadiq, Advocate, 2nd Allottee of Chamber No. 315 seeking time for payment.

The office has reported that the Advocate has paid his dues of Licence Fee and Maintenance Charges till August, 2018. Since the allottee has paid his dues, the matter be deleted from the agenda with the direction to allottee to ensure timely payment of dues in future.

G. Complaints:-

27. Undated complaint received from Sh. S.K. Tiwari, Advocate, 2nd Allottee of Chamber No.576 on 04.12.2017 against his co-allottee, Sh. S.P. Tripathi for let out the said chamber and to alter the structure of the said chamber.

It is informed by the President & Secretary of Saket Bar Association that the matter has been resolved. Since the issue has already been resolved, the matter be deleted from the agenda.

28. Note-sheet dated 10.04.2018 received from General Admn. Branch regarding representation of Sh. Bharat Bhushan, Advocate.

It is observed by the Committee that complaint of Ms. Usha Rani was sent to Sh. Bharat Bhushan, allottee of chamber No. 401 for his comments. In his response, it is submitted by Sh. Bharat Bhushan that at the time of allotment in 2014, his SBA Membership was B-119 and his Membership was temporarily cancelled for non-payment of membership fee without any intimation/notice and now his SBA membership has been restored with immediate effect having SBA Membership No.B-427. This has been confirmed by the Ld. President & Hony. Secretary of SBA.

Since, at the time of allotment of chamber, he was the member of the SBA,

no further action is required in this matter in view of the restoration of his membership, it is unanimously resolved that the matter be filed.

29. Note dated 05.03.2018 received from Genl. Admn. Branch regarding complaint against Sh. Kuldeep Singh Tomar, Advocate (Allottee No.2) of Chamber No.447, Saket Court Complex, New Delhi.
Deferred.

H. Miscellaneous Matters:-

30(A). Representation dated 14.05.2018 of Sh. Anil Kumar Bakshi, Advocate regarding status of chamber No.233 having size less than 120 sq. ft.

It is noticed by the Committee that in the minutes of meeting held on 07.06.2017, the representation dated 29.06.2015 of the applicant was considered and it was resolved that as the nomenclature and specification of the chamber cannot be changed, the said representation was unanimously rejected.

Since the matter has already been disposed of, the representation dated 14.05.2018 of Sh. Anil Kumar Bakshi is unanimously rejected and the matter be deleted from the agenda.

30(B). Complaint against Sh. Anil Kumar Bakshi.

It is informed by the office that the matter has been received from the Genl. Admn. Branch regarding complaint against Sh. Anil Kumar Bakshi for refusing to hand over the physical possession of half space of Chamber No.233 to co-allottee i.e. Ms. Susheela Prakash Sisodia.

It is unanimously resolved that Show Cause Notice be issued to Sh. Anil Kumar Bakshi as to why action should not be taken against him for cancellation of his allotment for preventing his co-allottee from entering in the chamber, with the directions that he will permit Ms. Susheela Prakash Sisodia to take over the possession of her slot in Chamber No. 233. Response be submitted within 15 days failing which office may break open the lock of said chamber in the presence of Bar Executives, President & Secretary and Security In-Charge. They will also ensure physical possession of half chamber to Ms. Susheela Prakash Sisodia.

31 (A) Show Cause Notice to Sh. P.K. Lal, Advocate.

It is observed by the Committee that vide minutes of meeting held on 16.07.2018, show cause notice was issued to Sh. P.K. Lal, Advocate for cancellation of his chamber in view of the following facts:-

1. Violation of terms and conditions of the allotment of chamber;
2. Suspension of Membership by the Saket Bar Association; and
3. Arrest in FIR No.415 dated 15.07.2018 at PS Saket.

Office has submitted the reply of his wife on behalf of the applicant. Matter is deferred for further consideration.

31 (B) Representation dated 17.07.2018 of Sh. Naresh Kumar Advocate, 1st Allottee of Chamber No.247.

Representation dated 17.07.2018 of Sh. Naresh Kumar Advocate, 1st Allottee of Chamber No.247 requesting to convert temporarily the chamber No.247 from Double Occupancy Basis into Single Occupancy basis has been considered. Since the chamber is earmarked for allotment on double occupancy basis, the representation is unanimously declined. He be informed accordingly.

32. Note dated 28.07.2018 received from Genl. Admn. Branch regarding clarification on the security amount deposited by deceased Sh. Rakesh Gautam, Advocate, 1st allottee of chamber No.654.

It is observed by the Committee that vide minutes of meeting held on 16.05.2018, the Committee unanimously allowed the request of Ms. Seema Gautam W/o Late Sh. Rakesh Gautam to waive off the Licence Fee and Maintenance Charges of Chamber No.654 allotted to her deceased husband Late Sh. Rakesh Gautam.

It is unanimously resolved that Security Amount be also returned to Ms. Seema Gautam W/o Late Sh. Rakesh Gautam.

33. Note dated 28.07.2018 received from Security Cell regarding provision of locking of doors of Lawyers Chamber Block to restrict access to chambers during off office hours.

The recommendations made by the Security Cell are unanimously accepted. They shall form part of the Lawyers' Chambers Allotment Rules. It is also unanimously resolved that no vendors will be allowed in the Lawyers Chambers Block. Sh. Sanjiv Jain, Officer In-Charge (Security) agreed to take up the matter in the Security Meeting.

34. Copy of report of ACJ's received on 02.07.2016 regarding inspection of Lawyers Chamber Block.

It is unanimously resolved to file the said report in view of several active steps taken by the Saket Bar Association. However, fresh report be called for from the ACJ of both the Districts.

The Office is also directed to start process to remove all the unauthorized occupants in coordination with Security Cell and Executive of the Bar.

35. Arrangement of Electricity connection for office & Library of SBA.

Deferred.

36. Report of ACJ (South) regarding various shops in Lawyers Chamber Block.

It is unanimously resolved to file the said report in view of several active steps taken by the Saket Bar Association. However, fresh report be called for.

37. Complaint regarding trespassing in un-allotted chambers & Store Rooms in Lawyers Chamber Block received from Sh. Satish Sharma, Advocate, Allottee of Chamber No.606.

The office is directed to initiate the process to remove unauthorized occupants immediately.

38 Non-use of chambers.

The Office is directed to make a list of such chambers which are not being used by the allottee despite allotment so that same can be allotted to the other needy advocates.

Other matter with the permission of the chair:-

1. Note dated 22.09.2018 received from Genl. Admn. Branch alongwith the application of Shri Ashok Mathur, Advocate, 1st allottee of Chamber No.255 for restoration of his chamber.

Allotment of Sh. Ashok Mathur, Advocate was cancelled vide MoM dated 09.10.2017 due to non payment of Licence fees & Maintenance Charges against 1st slot of Chamber No.255. Office has reported that the allottee has now paid his due till December, 2018 and submitted an application for restoration of chamber.

It is unanimously resolved that first slot of chamber No.255 be restored to its allottee with the direction to ensure timely payment of dues in future.

2. Fresh list of defaulters with regards to payment to Licence Fee and Maintenance Charges received from General Branch.

The office has put up the fresh list of defaulters who have not paid their Licence Fee and Maintenance Charges.

On perusal of list as Annexure "A" of these minutes, allottee of chamber no. 223 enlisted at S.N. 1, Sh. Narender Kumar Malawaliya has defaulted in payments since August, 2016 and allottees of chamber nos. 707, 704 & 769 at S.No.2 to 4, Sh. Rajiv Kumar Chauhan, Sh. Arbind Yadav & Sh. Sunil Kumar Ahlawat respectively have defaulted in their payments despite opportunities given vide minutes of meeting dated 09.10.2017. It is unanimously resolved that the allotment of chambers of the abovesaid allottees be cancelled. As regards to remaining, the office is directed to issue show cause notice to the defaulters who have not paid their dues for more than six months. The office shall take possession of the cancelled chambers/slots so that allotment can be effected in the next meeting on the basis of the notices already issued and considered vide item No.13.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks.
