Sub: Implementation of the judgment dated 04.01.2024 of the Hon'ble Supreme Court passed in Writ Petition (Civil) No.643 of 2015 titled as "All India Judges Association Vs. Union of India and others".

Sir/ Madam,

In continuation of letter No. 19177/CSCDJ/DHC dated 30.09.2024, letter No. 19454/CSCDJ/DHC dated 04.10.2024, letter No. 19815/CSCDJ/DHC dated 09.10.2024 and letter No. 19884/CSCDJ/DHC dated 14.10.2024 forwarded by this Office on the above mentioned subject I am directed to forward herewith Revised Annexure A [to Annexure Y of the Minutes of the Meeting dated 27.09.2024] wherein the following clause in the second paragraph of the certificate Annexure A stand deleted:-

"I further certify that I have not/ have (mention the one which is applicable) utilized the services of my driving-knowing office attendant/ peon/ orderly for driving my car, on an almost regular basis, for official purpose"

Furthermore, the similar provision in clause 2 (i) of Annexure Y of the Minutes of the Meeting dated 27.09.2024 shall also stand deleted.

In addition to above, I am further directed to inform you that real brother or real sister of the Judicial Officer be also included in clause 2 (i) (after the words parents or children or parents-in-law) of Annexure Y as well as in Annexure A (in first paragraph after the words father-in-law/ mother-in-law).

I am also directed to inform that other issues raised in the communication dated 16.10.2024 of the office of Principal District & Sessions Judge (HQs) in the matter of implementation of the instant directions have also been considered by the Committee for Service Condition of District Judiciary which inter alia resolved as under:-

- (i) *The direction regarding enhanced rate of Robe Allowance is to be implemented from 01.01.2016. Accordingly in case of any judicial officer, if the previous block year with respect to payment of robe allowance coincides with the year 2016, then such judicial officer may be paid Robe Allowance at the enhanced rate with effect from 01.01.2016 for the remaining period/ block beyond 01.01.2016 on pro rata basis.*

- (ii) *The judicial officers on deputation, who had opted for payment of Transport Allowance at the rates specified under 7th CPC, as available in the borrowing/ deputation departments, as opposed to reimbursement of 100/ 75 litres of fuel, will not be additionally entitled for payment of Conveyance/ Transport Allowance [@ Rs. 10,000/- or Rs. 13,500/-] as per SNJPC.*
- (iii) *The Govt. of NCT of Delhi may be requested to furnish its comments on the issue of payment of transport/ conveyance allowance [@ Rs. 10,000/- or Rs. 13,500/-] at double the aforesaid rates to officers from PwD category.*
- (iv) *In case of deceased judicial officers, the arrears of allowances may be disbursed to the entitled legal heir(s), subject to their filing a proper application/ representation along with the requisite certificates.*
- (v) *The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide orders dated 05.02.2008 and 22.04.2008 passed in Writ Petition 1022/1989 had directed to extend the benefits of the Shetty Commission to those judicial officers who are working on "deputation". Accordingly the judicial officers on deputation would be entitled to the allowances at the enhanced rates as specified in the judgment dated 04.01.2024. However the same will be payable by the deputation/ borrowing departments for the period the officers remained on deputation, subject to any further understanding between Delhi District Courts and such deputation/ borrowing departments regarding calculation and disbursement of such allowances by Delhi District Courts and their subsequent reimbursement by such deputation/ borrowing departments.*

The above stated information is for your information and necessary compliance.
