Vide it's order dated 05.08.2019, petitioner was directed to submit copy of certified copies filed in Hon'ble High Court on which she relied upon, to the Lawyers' Chamber Allotment Committee (LCAC). Simultaneously, it directed the LCAC to consider the Petitioner's representation afresh</p>

		<p>for allotment of chamber.</p> <p>During initial scrutiny, documents in three cases were already found valid for establishing her as Main Counsel and the LCAC in it's meeting dated 04.04.2024 found documents in eleven (11) cases filed with her representation as valid to establish the Petitioner as "Main Counsel". As such, she was established as "Main Counsel" in fourteen (14) cases against required fifteen (15) cases, which do not support her to fulfill the criteria of eligibility.</p> <p>In case titled as M/s Agrimas Chemicals Pvt. Ltd. Vs. Ram Akbal Sharma, she filed with her representation certified copies of two (2) vakalatnamas which do not bear case nos., thus, the said two cases were treated as one case. She was given opportunity of hearing in person before the Administrative Civil Judges (South & South East). However, she could not able to submit any document to prove the above vakatalnamas belonging to two (2) different cases.</p> <p>The Petitioner again moved to the Hon'ble High Court through WP (C) 12802/2024 and with her said Writ Petition, she filed certified copies in case no. 2105/2014 & 2106/2014 having similar title i.e. M/s Agrimas Chemicals Ltd. Vs. Shri Ram Akbal Sharma.</p> <p>The Hon'ble High Court in it's order dated 30.09.2024 held that "the certified documents of the entire paper book alone could have clarified the issue and therefore, this is not a case as if the Petitioner is filing additional documents to establish this eligibility. 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		<p>eligibility criteria have only been clarified through the certified copies”.</p> <p>Accordingly Hon'ble High Court has directed petitioner to furnish the certified copies clearly delineating the complaint case number along with the Vakalatnama which shall then be placed before the Committee, who shall then take a fresh decision thereon.
