The Sub-Committee has referred to Allotment Rules and the Judgment of Supreme Court passed on 20.01.2024 in Writ Petition (Civil) 48/2024 titled as Anamika Dewan Vs. Registrar Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. In its judgment the Hon'ble Apex Court has dismissed the petition on the ground that at the time of death of the allottee, the petitioner i.e. daughter of allottee, Ms. Anamika Dewan wasn't a practicing lawyer in Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
