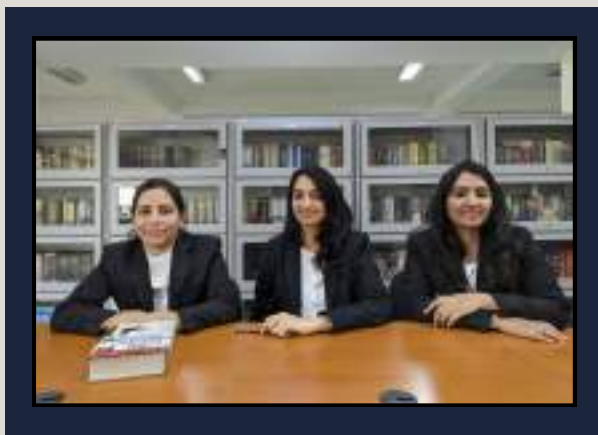

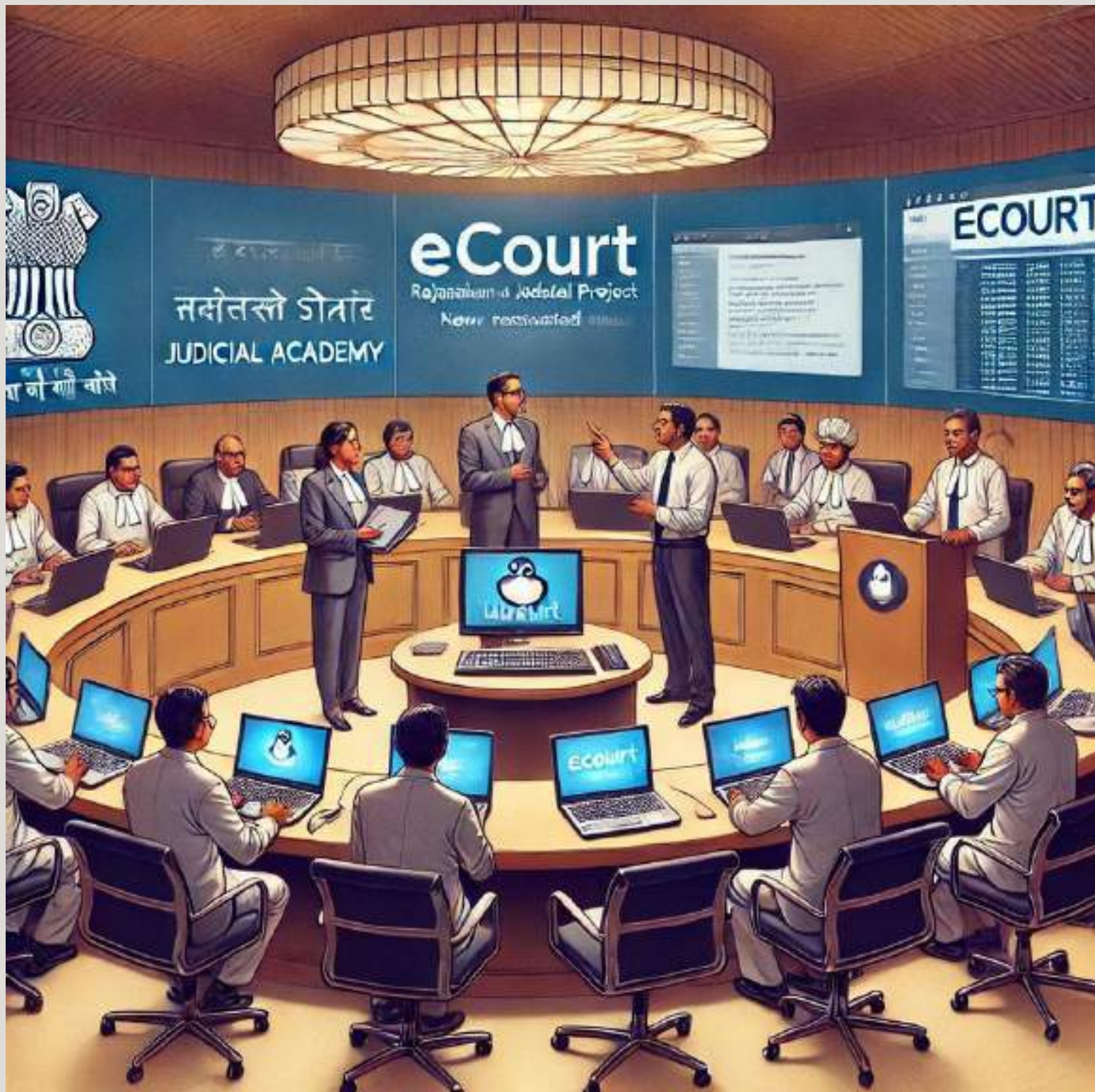

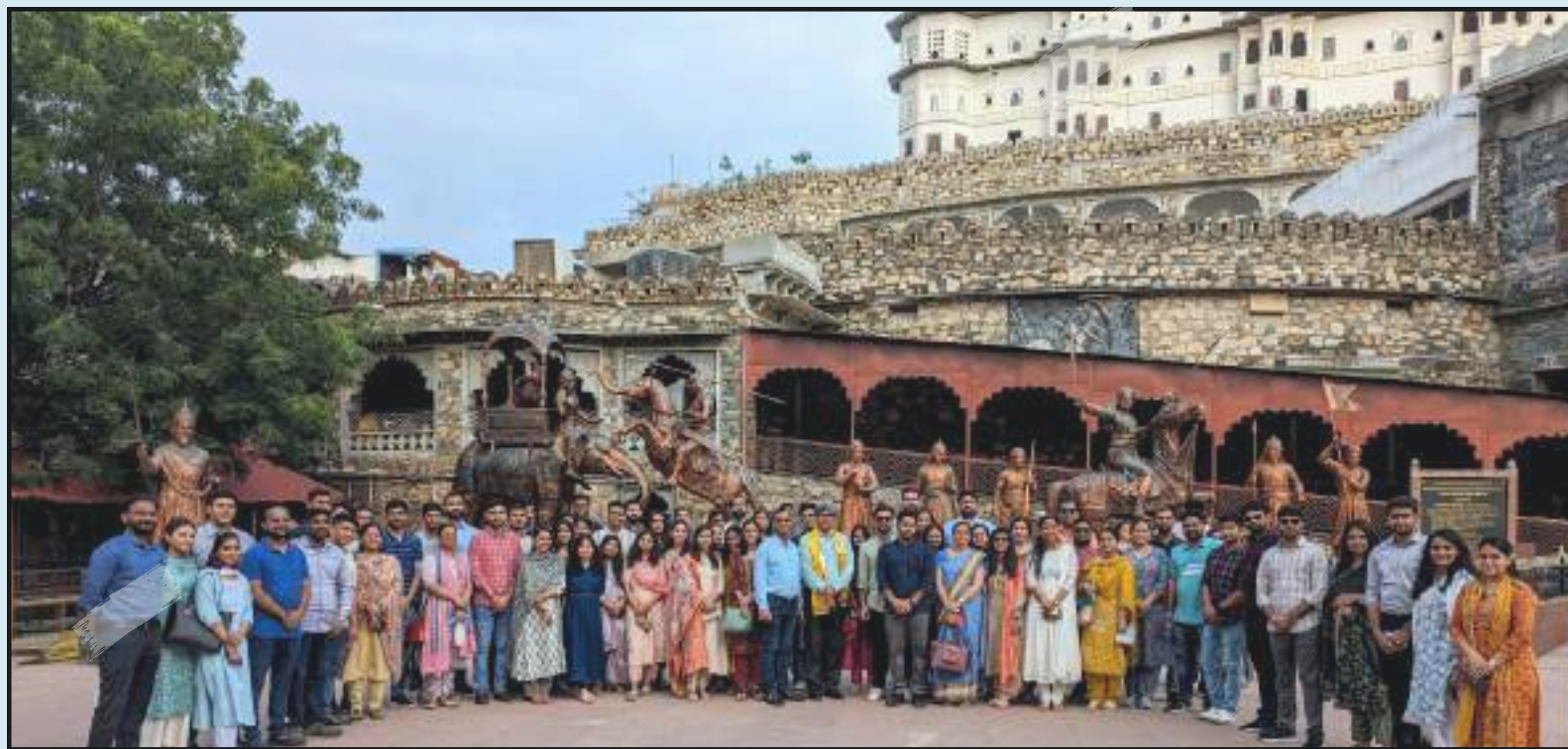

Speech of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Surya Kant, Judge, Supreme Court of India, at the Valedictory Ceremony

Two eminent jurists, who are my colleagues in the Supreme Court, my brother Justice Augustine George Masih and Justice Sandeep Mehta Das, Chief Justice M.M. Shrivastava, Hon'ble Chief Justice of the Rajasthan High Court, and Chairman of the Rajasthan State Judicial Academy, Justice P.S. Bhati, Chairperson of the Rajasthan State Judicial Academy, Justice Dinesh Mehta, my brother and sister judges of the Rajasthan High Court, respected dignitaries, faculty, and officers of the Rajasthan High Court establishment, the esteemed Director and faculty of the Rajasthan State Judicial Academy, and my very dear judicial officers, it is evident that you are physically and mentally ready to join the battlefield of justice. Members of the legal fraternity, ladies, and gentlemen, I feel it is a great honor to be here with you at this valedictory function marking the completion of your induction training.

I would like to extend my heartfelt congratulations to each one of you for successfully completing this training, which undoubtedly heralds the beginning of a noble and challenging journey in the realm of justice. Justice Dr. Bhati, Chief Justice Shrivastava, my brother Justice Sandeep Mehta, and Justice Masih have eloquently given you a comprehensive insight into the practical scenarios you will face when you begin presiding over courts, perhaps as early as Monday.

I'm confident that, in addition to the guidance you received from today's speakers, the dedicated faculty and frequent distinguished visitors at the Judicial Academy, including Hon'ble Judges, have sensitized you to the responsibilities and challenges that await you as judicial officers. One of the young lady judicial officers very eloquently described the various regions of Rajasthan, where each of you will be spread across the state. Each region has its own dialect, weather, and types of litigation. What you may find in Sri Ganganagar may differ from the litigation in Jaisalmer. These are challenges for the newly trained judicial officers, the judicial "army," as I call you, ready to face the legal battlefield. Some of the things that my colleagues have spoken about today need not be repeated, but it has been well explained to you how important it is to stay positive in your fieldwork. Justice Sandeep Mehta has explained how, in cases where judicial discretion lies with you, you should lean towards a relief-oriented approach. The advantages of technology, particularly artificial intelligence (AI), have also been highlighted. As judicial officers, you are "judges 24/7," which should sensitize you to conduct yourself beyond court hours in a manner that reflects the dignity of your role.

Handling the court, managing lawyers, and dealing with the challenges of the legal profession are significant responsibilities. Some of these tasks might make you feel daunted, but with the right mindset, you will rise to the occasion. Statutes sometimes present a static and disappointing picture, but as a judicial officer, your art is to find a path to real and true justice, without doing violence to the law. This is a challenge every judge faces, whether at the Supreme Court or as a judicial magistrate.

You, as judicial officers at the grassroots level, are often the first point of contact for litigants. Many litigants may never make it to Jodhpur, Jaipur, or Delhi to see us in the higher courts. Your role is critical because you are the face of justice for them. When they leave your court, even if they lose their case, it should be because of the merits of the case and not because of any procedural inadequacies.

Speech of Hon'ble Mr. Justice Surya Kant, Judge, Supreme Court of India, at the Valedictory Ceremony

Your role as a judicial officer is not just about adhering to procedural niceties, but about maintaining physical and mental well-being for the long journey ahead. My brothers have rightly pointed out that health—both physical and mental—is critical for this challenging career. Control over your staff, compassion towards litigants, and an understanding of the societal context in which cases arise will help you navigate this long and sometimes difficult journey.

In your role, compassion is key. Litigants come to you with hopes that you represent the temple of justice. Whether the litigant is a plaintiff or a defendant, both deserve your compassion. But remember, there are also "invisible victims" of the legal system who may not be present in court. Your responsibility extends to these individuals as well. Sometimes, you may have to act as both plaintiff and defendant for them, understanding their plight and ensuring justice is done.

Let me share an example of how compassion and a sense of justice played out in my own experience as a judge. In a civil revision case I heard as a High Court judge, three minor sisters had filed a suit against their father, who was convicted for murdering their mother. During the litigation, I uncovered a series of unlawful transactions concerning their family property. Over five years, I passed several orders to restore justice to the girls. I canceled the sale deeds, penalized the buyers, and ensured the girls received financial and educational support. One of the girls graduated, and I even received her wedding invitation later. These moments of delivering justice remind us of the profound impact we can have on people's lives.

As judges, we must possess integrity, impartiality, and independence. These are not qualifications but the very essence of being a judicial officer. Without these values, our role as judges is meaningless. I once heard a story of a high court judge who ruled against the brother-in-law of the then Chief Justice, not knowing the connection. When questioned, he responded that his judgment would have been the same even if he had known. That kind of integrity is essential.

Competence and diligence are equally critical. Artificial intelligence and technology may assist you, but it is your competence, developed through regular reading and understanding of the law, that will set you apart. You must read legal journals, books, and judgments to constantly improve your knowledge. This habit will help you apply the law correctly, even when faced with complex or unconventional cases.

In conclusion, this valedictory ceremony marks the beginning of your judicial career, not the end of your learning. You will face challenges, but with compassion, competence, and integrity, you will rise to meet them. Remember, you are the "voice of the voiceless," and your role in the judicial system is vital for ensuring justice is delivered to all.
