To All the Presiding Officers of the Subordinate Courts including Officers on deputation.

Sub. : Observation of Punctuality by the Judicial Officers of the Subordinate Courts.

Despite the directions issued vide P.I.Circular No.2, dated 4/4/2001, No.5, dated 24/3/2006, No.8, dated 20/7/2007, No.11, dated 11/11/2009 and instructions issued from time to time for observing the punctuality and dress code by the Presiding Officers of the Subordinate Courts, a large number of complaints are being received that Judicial Officers are not sitting in Courts in time and / or are found sitting in Chambers during the Courts hours.

Therefore while reiterating the earlier instructions, it is enjoined upon all the Presiding Officers of the Subordinate Courts to strictly observe punctuality and not to sit in Chambers during the Courts hours.

The High Court shall be monitoring the same henceforth and deviation shall be viewed seriously.

The directions contained in the above P.I. Circulars issued by this Court in this regard may also be followed by the concerned.

Any departure from the directions issued by this Hon'ble Court, if any observed, shall be viewed seriously.

Therefore, while reiterating the directions contained in Circular No.35 dated 5.9.1957; No. 3/P.I. dated 1.5.1984; dated: 5.4.1986; No. 15/P.I. No. 10/P.I. dated: 9.11.1994; No.14/P.I. dated: 1.11.2000 & No. 2/PI, dated: 4.4,2001, and it was

enjoined upon all concerned to observe strictly court hours and also to wear the prescribed dress while sitting in Courts. It was further directed to take appropriate steps to ensure the observance of these instructions and to have surprise inspection of the Subordinate Courts within their jurisdiction by the District & Sessions Judges concerned about the punctuality and wearing of the prescribed dress and also to submit a report about the due observance, of the fules and instructions.

In order to ensure the observance of these instructions, it is directed that the District & Sessions Judges will make surprise inspections of the courts of their Judgeships, invariably and will send reports of such surprise inspections made by them, monthly/quarterly, to this Registry. The District & Sessions Judges are also directed to obtain explanations from all the defaulting officers, and to forward the same to the High Court, with their comments.

Any lapse in this regard, will be viewed seriously.
