Upon approval of the Hon'ble High Court, Madras in ROC.No.22295A/2024/Comp3, the Coimbatore District Judiciary hereby notifies that the facility of mandatory e-Filing of cases is extended to the Second Appeal, Criminal Appeal and all the Bail Applications and all the criminal MPs dealing with relaxation of condition, extension of time for furnishing sureties and modification of Bail condition .,etc., in the Madras high Court, Madurai Bench of Madras High Court and to the Bail Applications and its allied matters, Partition Suits, Mortgage Suits, Evictions Suits, Suits for possession, Pre-emption Suits, Suits for Accounts, Suits for dissolution of Partnership and Specific performance suits in the District Judiciary on e-filing portal (<https://filing.ecourts.gov.in>) developed by the Hon'ble e-Committee, Supreme Court of India which commenced **from 01.04.2024**.

The detailed guidelines and tutorial video prepared by the Madras High Court for the e-filing process and the detailed user manual prepared by the Hon'ble e-Committee, Supreme Court of India along with the steps required to be taken as per the existing practice of the Madras High Court, are available in the website of Madras High Court (<http://www.hcmadras.tn.nic.in>) and in the website of the Coimbatore District Court (<http://coimbatore.dcourts.gov.in/>).
