NOTIFICATION

As per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Madras, in the letter in ROC.No.22295A/2024/Comp3 dated 31.05.2024, it is notified that the Mandatory e-filing of cases is extended to the Second Appeal, Criminal Appeal and all Bail Applications and all Criminal MPs dealing with relaxation of condition, extension of time for furnishing sureties and modification of Bail Condition, etc., in the Madras High Court, Madurai Bench of Madras High Court and to the Bail Applications and its allied matters, Partition Suits, Mortgage Suits, Eviction Suits, Suits for Possession, Pre-emption Suits, Suits for Accounts, Suits for dissolution of partnership and Specific Performance Suits in the District Judiciary is to be implemented on the e-filing portal (<https://filing.ecourts.gov.in>) on and **from 01.04.2024**. Subsequently, the Hon'ble High Court of Madras has made partial modification of the aforesaid Notification with regard to mandatory e-filing w.e.f. 01.04.2024 and a Notification in this regard was hosted in the website informing that mandatory e-filing will commence on and **from 03.06.2024**. Now, the Hon'ble High Court of Madras has proposed to **postponed** the mandatory e-filing of the aforesaid case types, until further orders.
