

- Notices be issued in advance to all the parties from 01-08-2024 onwards.
- Take necessary steps to have Pre-Lok Adalat sittings and to conciliate between the parties to arrive at a settlement.
- Sufficient number of Lok Adalat Benches be constituted to avoid referring more number of cases to any of the Benche;

The Chairpersons of DLSAs shall instruct all the MLSCs in the district and others concerned, and ensure disposal of good number of pending cases in the ensuing National Lok Adalat to be held on 14-09-2024 (Second Saturday).

You are requested to submit weekly statement to this Authority by 2.00 p.m., on every Thursday starting from 08-08-2024 in the enclosed proforme.
