### **INSTRUCTIONS**

- I. Vacancy for which applications are called for -Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class, Dharmavaram
- II. Enclosures: Attested copies of certificates in proof of age, educational and other qualifications, service shall be enclosed. Non-practising Advocates shall enclose attested copies of certificate that at present he/she is not on the rolls of the Bar Council and certificate showing their practice period at the Bar as Advocate.

#### 111. **QUALIFICATIONS:**

A person shall be qualified for appointment as Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class, if a person

- i) held any post in Andhra Pradesh Judicial Service and retired or resigned (OR)
- held a post in the A.P.Judicial Ministerial Subordinate Service not below the rank of Superintendent (Category-III of A.P.Judicial Ministerial & Subordinate Service Rules, 2019) in the State of Andhra Pradesh and has a Law Degree (OR)
- iii) held a post of Section Officer and above in the Andhra Pradesh High Court Service and has a Law Degree (OR)
- iv) practiced as an advocate atleast for five years and at present not on the rolls of the Bar Council (OR)
- v) being any retired Gazetted Officer possessing Law Degree or who has passed the Criminal Judicial Test in full test consisting of Indian Penal Code and the Code of Criminal Procedure or the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 conducted by the Andhra Pradesh Public Service Commission and who has exercised Magisterial powers during his tenure of service for not less than three years;

provided that a suitable retired Judicial Officer will be given preference.

# IV. DISQUALIFICATIONS:

A person

i) who is a practicing advocate;

ii) who is a Member of any State or Local Authority; OR

iii) who is a Member of the State Legislature or of the Parliament; OR

iv) having held an Officer under the State or the Union Government or any Local Authority has been dismissed or removed or compulsorily retired from service or subjected to any other major penalty for misconduct; OR

v) who has been convicted and sentenced by a court for an offence involving moral delinquency or is charged of any offence constituting moral turpitude and

proceedings are pending; OR

vi) a person of unsound mind or who is deaf or mute or blind or suffering from leprosy or any other contagious diseases; OR

vii) in a bigamous marriage; OR

viii) a woman whose marriage is void by reason of the husband having a wife living of the a woman whose marriage or who has married a person who has a wife living at the

time of such marriage; ix) adjudicated as an insolvent or an undischarged insolvent; OR

x) being a contractor or a businessman or one interested in subsisting contract or any work being done for Central or State Government or a Local Authority within whose limits the Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class has to discharge his duties;

shall not be eligible.

### V. Age:

Non-practicing advocate with a practice at the Bar of not less than five years and who is above 45 years and below 65 years of age and in respect of retired persons who have atleast one and a half year to complete 65 years of age, as on the date of Notification, shall alone be eligible.

# VI. Unit of appointment:

Except as otherwise provided in 'The Andhra Pradesh Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class Service Rules, 2024', since the judicial districts are not bifurcated for judiciary in the State of Andhra Pradesh, the Unit of appointment shall be the respective judicial districts of the candidate to which he belong to.

# VII. REVOCATION OF POWERS OF SPECIAL JUDICIAL MAGISTRATE OF II CLASS:

If any complaint as to the misconduct of the Special Judicial Magistrate of II (i) Class is received by the High Court, the same shall be placed before the Committee dealing with the subject. If, on perusal of the complaint, the Committee is of the opinion that the officer has resorted to any acts of misconduct, or has derelicted his duties, a show cause notice, of not less than 15 days, requiring him to explain, shall be issued.

On consideration of the explanation offered by the officer, if the Committee finds that any act of misconduct or dereliction of duty was resorted by the officer, Committee may make appropriate recommendation. for termination of the services of the officer, which in turn shall be forwarded to the Government. The order so passed would be final.

- On appointment and while in service, a Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class (ii)may be removed without being called upon to show cause if he fails to attend three consecutive sittings of the Court without a written permission of the concerned Chief Judicial Magistrate.
- Powers conferred by the Court on Special Judicial Magistrate of II Class shall (iii) automatically stand withdrawn on attaining the age of 65 years.
