

MOST RESPECTFULLY SHOWETH:

1. That the present petition has been filed under Article 136 of the Constitution of India seeking special leave to appeal against the Impugned Judgment and Final Order dated 31.07.2018 passed by the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Hyderabad for the State of Telangana and the State of Andhra Pradesh in Appeal Suit No. 469 of 1997 and Cross Appeal (SR) No. 14514 of 2015 and I.A. No. 1 of 2016 (ASMP No. 408 of 2016) whereby the Hon'ble High Court was pleased to inter alia reject the Application for condonation of delay in filing the Cross Appeal and consequently the delay in filing the Cross Appeal was not condoned. Accordingly, the Cross Appeal was also rejected. Further, the Amended Plaint filed by the Petitioners / Plaintiffs was not permitted to be looked into.

1 A. The Appellant No. 1 before the Hon'ble High Court (Respondent No.1 herein) had died on 10.06.2010 i.e. during the pendency of the Appeal before the Hon'ble High Court. Since all his legal representative were already on record, as appellant No. 2 to 5 no separate application was moved to bring on record his LRs. Consequently, all the Legal Representatives of the deceased Appellant No.1 (before the Hon'ble High Court) are already on record before this Hon'ble Court and hence there is no necessity of filing an application to bring on record his L.Rs.
