1. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted a status report in view of the earlier order passed by this Court on 10.01.2022, according to which the investigation is complete and the Charge Sheet has been filed against all the accused including the respondent No.1.

3. Now, since the investigation is over and Charge Sheet has been filed and since the learned counsel for the petitioner has not been able to bring on record anything adverse against the respondent No.1, namely, any breach of the conditions, on which the anticipatory bail was granted, we do not think it proper to continue with the present proceedings. There also does not seem to be any requirement of custodial interrogation of the respondent No.1, in view of the Charge Sheet filed by the respondent-State.

4. In that view of the matter, the present Special Leave Petition is dismissed.
