NOTIFICATION

As directed by the Hon'ble Chairman, APHCLSC, the A.P. High Court Mediation and Arbitration Centre called for applications from the Advocates, of the Bar Association, High Court of A.P., Retd. Judges, In-service Judicial Officers, Retd. Senior Bureaucrats, Retd. Senior Executives for empanelling them as mediators in addition to the existing panel of Mediators in A.P. High Court Mediation Centre and to identify names of persons who are inactive in the existing panel.

In this regard, applications are invited from the willing persons as mentioned in Rule 12 of Alternative Dispute Resolutions and Mediation Rules, 2017, High Court of A.P., to empanel them as mediators for the High Court of Andhra Pradesh.

As per Rule-12 of the Alternative Dispute Resolutions and Mediation Rules, 2017, the following persons shall be treated as qualified and eligible for being enlisted in the panel of mediators:

1. (i) Retired Judges of the Supreme Court of India,
(ii) Retired Judges of the High Court;
(iii) Retired District and Sessions Judges or retired Judges of the City Civil Courts or Courts of equivalent status;
(iv) In-service Judicial Officers; and
2. Legal practitioners with atleast **seven(07) years'** standing at the Bar;
3. Experts or other professionals with at least **fifteen(15) years'** standing; or retired senior bureaucrats or retired senior executives;

4. Institutions which are themselves experts in mediation and have been recognized as such by the High Court, provided the names of its members are approved by the High Court initially or whenever there is change in membership.
5. The Mediator who have undergone training programme conducted in accordance with the curriculum approved by Mediation and Conciliation Project Committee of India (MCPC) shall alone be accredited as Mediator.


