Sub:- Establishment – Civil Judicial District, Kalpetta –constitute a Medi Care Cell -Details of members of the Medi Care Cell – Regarding.

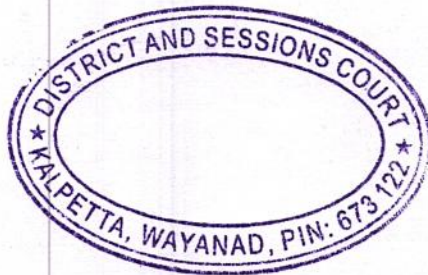
Ref:- Official Memorandum No.R.9/2023/DI-3 dated 28.02.2023 of the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala.

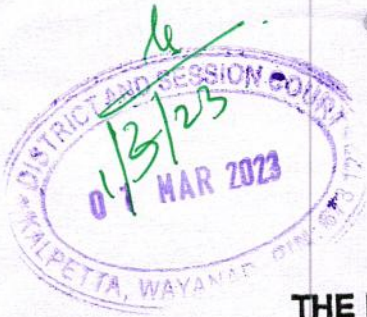

OFFICIAL MEMORANDUM

Sub: Constituion of 'Medi Care Cell' in each District for the expeditious disursement of medical reimbursement to the retired Judicial Officers- reg.

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Upon considering the difficulties faced by the retired judicial officers in getting timely assistance from the staff members of the District Court for the reimbursement of their medical claims, this Court has decided to constitute a 'Medi Care Cell' in each District Court for the expeditious processing of the medical claims submitted by the retired judicial officers.

Accordingly, all Principal District Judges shall constitute a 'Medi Care Cell' in the District Court, which shall be headed by the Court Manager. In the District Courts where Court Manager is not available, the Cell shall be headed by the Senior Superintendent. A Clerk and a Computer Assistant/ Typist shall also be entrusted the additional charge of the 'Cell'. An Office Attendant or a Process Server shall be posted exclusively to it.

The Cell shall help the retired judicial officers in processing their medical reimbursement claims promptly. The Cell shall also provide them assistance in case of medical emergencies. The Principal District Judges shall ensure that the 'Cell' is functioning effectively so that the retired judicial officers do not face any difficulty in processing their claims.


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If the retired judicial officers request for assistance to prepare claim form of reimbursement or for collecting the form or bills from their residence, the Cell shall provide such help through the Nazerette concerned, wherever it is feasible and without incurring additional expenditure.

The contact details of the officer heading the Cell shall be appropriately published, so that the retired judicial officers shall be able to contact them for any assistance in the matter.

All Principal District Judges shall intimate this Court once the 'Cell' is constituted. They shall also intimate the commencement of the 'Medi Care Cell' to all the retired judicial officers residing in the district and also to the subordinate courts in their respective judicial district and upload information on the constitution of the Cell in their respective websites.
