As part of the activities to mark the 75<sup>th</sup> year of the establishment of the Supreme Court of India, a National Conference of the District Judiciary is being organised by the Supreme Court of India on 31 August and 1 September 2024. The Conference will be inaugurated by Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India. Smt Droupadi Murmu, Hon'ble President of India will deliver the valedictory address on 1 September 2024. The venue for the Conference will be the Convention Centre at Bharat Mandapam, Pragati Maidan, New Delhi. The proposed programme for the Conference is attached.

This first-of-its-kind National Conference will bring together more than 800 judicial officers from across India to discuss critical issues concerning the district judiciary. The Conference will focus on access to justice and the effective administration of law and justice within the district judiciary.

This Conference serves as a continuation of the All India District Court Judges' Conference, which was jointly organised by the Supreme Court of India and the High Court of Gujarat on 2 March 2024 in Kachchh, Gujarat. About 250 judicial officers from district courts across all States participated in the Conference and contributed valuable insights to improve the functioning of the judiciary.

My colleagues and I have pleasure in inviting you to participate in the inaugural and valedictory events and in the Conference spread over two days.

As part of the activities to mark the 75<sup>th</sup> year of the establishment of the Supreme Court of India, a National Conference of the District Judiciary is being organised by the Supreme Court of India on 31 August and 1 September 2024. The Conference will be inaugurated by Shri Narendra Modi, Hon'ble Prime Minister of India. Smt. Droupadi Murmu, Hon'ble President of India will deliver the valedictory address on 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2024. The venue for the Conference will be the Convention Centre at Bharat Mandapam, Pragati Maidan, New Delhi. The proposed programme for the Conference is attached.

Hon'ble the Chief Justice of India has already addressed a letter to Hon'ble Chief Justice of your High Court inviting him for the Conference. Hon'ble the Chief Justice of India has requested me to coordinate with Registrar Generals of all the High Courts to nominate judicial officers for the Conference. Insofar as your High Court is concerned, 19 judicial officers of the cadre of District Judge (9), Civil Judge (Senior Division) (5) and Civil Judge (Junior Division) (5) are to be nominated for participating physically in the Conference and all other judicial officers will participate virtually.

You are, therefore, requested to nominate the judicial officers, as indicated above, accordingly and send their names with their designation to Mr. Rakesh Kumar, Registrar (Judges' Admn) by 24<sup>th</sup> August, 2024 on email id- [registrar.protocol@sci.nic.in](mailto:registrar.protocol@sci.nic.in).

By way of a separate communication the Chief Secretary of State of Andhra Pradesh has been requested to reserve 10 rooms in the State Guest House(s) of State of Andhra Pradesh in New Delhi for the judicial officers for the period 30<sup>th</sup> August, 2024 to 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2024. The rooms to be reserved in the State Guest House(s) will be on twin sharing basis. You may, therefore,


coordinate with the State authorities insofar as reservation of rooms is concerned.
