In continuation of Employment Advertisement got published by this office in two newspapers, i.e. 'Jagat Kranti' and 'The Tribune' in issues dated 23.01.2024 respectively for filling up 36 posts of Clerks on Ad hoc basis and also vacancies notified to the Employment Exchange, Nuh. it is notified that the Written Test (General Knowledge and English Composition) of eligible candidates will be held on 25.02.2024.

The roll number of the candidates are mentioned against their form number and name in the list of eligible candidates as uploaded on the website. No separate admit card shall be issued in this regard.

If any candidate does not report as per schedule above, he shall not be allowed to take examination.

The candidates shall have to take a written examination in the following subjects:

Sr. No.	Subject	Maximum Marks	Qualifying Marks
1.	General Knowledge- Part -A	50	33%
2.	English Composition-Part-B	50	33%

The candidates who obtain less than 40% marks in aggregate in the written examination shall not be considered eligible for Computer Proficiency Test. In case any candidate obtains less than 33% in Part-A paper, his Part-B paper shall not be evaluated and such candidate shall be considered as 'FAIL'.

Note:

Only three times candidates to the number of vacancies advertised shall be called to appear in the Computer Proficiency Test from the merit list of written examination.

Before attempting the questions, the candidate shall mention his/her particulars neatly and correctly at the top on each page of answer sheet against the relevant columns. Except at the top, the candidate shall not disclose his/her identity, in any manner whatsoever, at any other place in

the answer sheet. Any attempt in this regard shall render his candidature invalid.

Answers to the questions in Part-A shall be attempted by putting tick (✓) mark at the right answer on the sheet itself provided to each candidate. No cutting or overwriting of the tick mark is permitted.

More than one answer for one question in Part-A will earn **ZERO** mark. There will be **No Negative marking** for the wrong answer in the examination.

For Part-B paper, candidate shall be provided space in question paper itself for writing answers and will also be provided separate sheets of A4 size if demanded.

Use of mobile phone or any other such electronic device or any incriminating material is strictly prohibited and violation of this instruction shall result in cancellation of candidature.

The list of eligible candidates will be displayed/ uploaded on the official website of the office of learned District & Sessions Judge, Nuh, i.e. <https://districts.ecourts.gov.in/mewat>.

It is made clear that no individual information with regard to date, time and venue of examination will be sent to any of the candidates through any other mode.

The candidates shall bring along them photo-ID proof, preferably Aadhar Card, in order to ascertain their identity, at the venue of examination, and also carry blue ballpoint pen and clipboard to solve the question paper.
