OFFICE ORDER

In Continuation of this Office Order, bearing Endst. No.3429/EB dated 11.07.2023 for the purpose of exploring the possibility of making mandatory e-filing in the matter relating to the Revenue, Tax, Arbitration and Commercial Dispute matters. Now, the Bail Applications are also included for e-filing. Thus all the Advocates are hereby required to electronically file the Bail Applications at Headquarter Barnala online w.e.f. **01.02.2024** through e-filing portal i.e. <https://efiling-phc.ecourts.gov.in>.


It is made clear that after **10.02.2024**, e-filing of the Bail Applications shall be mandatory alongwith hard copies.

The Advocates who have not got themselves registered for e-filing are required to get themselves registered on the above mentioned portal of their own or can submit the hard-copy of duly fixed form in the prescribed proforma along with required documents to the e-Sewa Kendra, Barnala, before electronically filing the aforesaid cases and also to submit the hard copies of pleadings and documents within 3 days of the e-filing of the petition at the filing counter, provided that the cases will be listed for hearing only after filing of hard copies (as per e-filing guidelines as received from the Hon'ble High Court).

The training program regarding e-filing is scheduled on 20.01.2024 at 12:30 PM by the System Officer/System Assistant. All advocates to ensure their presence.

In case of any queries regarding the e-filing process, Advocates are requested to contact Concerned Clerks, e-Sewa Kendra of this Sessions Division as well as for any technical assistance may contact to System Officer, Server Room, of this Sessions Division.
