One retired Grade I Stenographer and one retired Senior Typist are required for appointment on ad-hoc basis under the following condition of the Odisha Fast Track Special Court Scheme, 2020. The desirous candidates are required to remain present in the District Court, Malkangiri with application in plain paper and supporting documents and fitness certificate on 08.04.2021 at 10.30 A.M. for selection.


The appointment of retired Ministerial Staffs employees shall be purely on contractual basis and initially for a period of one year.

Eligibility:

1. The appointment of Ministerial Staffs employees who have retired from service on attaining the age of Superannuation or on voluntary retirement having a clean service record shall only be considered for such appointment subject to suitability and must not above the age of 70 as on the date of publication of this advertisement. Further, who have been dismissed, removed, compulsorily retired from service or have sought voluntary retirement after initiation of Departmental Inquiry against them shall not be eligible to be considered for such ad-hoc appointment.

Pay and allowances:

1. A retired Ministerial Staff employee on appointment under the Scheme on ad-hoc basis shall be entitled to receive pay and allowance on the rate he/she drawing at the time of retirement minus total amount of pension being received by him after commutation under Pension Rule. He/She shall also be entitled to get other regular allowances admissible to the Staffs of the respective Cadres.
