4. The Magistrate on duty shall also perform the duty of protocol during his/her duty period under the supervision of undersigned/learned ACJM, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri.
5. The affidavits of the witnesses (deposing before learned Court of Sessions) pertaining to the sub division, Bilaspur shall be attested by the Duty Magistrate.

It is made clear that the affidavit of any person whose evidence is of formal character as provided in Section 296 Cr.P.C be attested by respective Court/ Illaqa Magistrate.
