CIRCULAR ORDER NO. 13 OF 2022

(CIVIL)

Insert the following as Sub-rules- (c) and (d) after the existing Sub-rule-(b) of Rule-548 of the G.R.& C.O. (Civil) Vol-I, 1985 Edition.

- (c) All women Judicial Officers should wear:-
- (i) White/black, full/half sleeve, high neck blouse/ shirt with collar
  - (ii) Sarees white/ cream/ grey/ black (or) combination thereof
  - (iii) Salwar/ Churidar/ trousers (White/ cream/ grey/ black)
  - (iv) Full sleeve black coat/ other Full Sleeve coat.

Note: Nothing should be worn which is likely to cause disturbance during the court proceedings or which is unbecoming to the dignity of a Judicial Officer.

- (d) On ceremonial occasions and official functions/ visits,
- (i) the male Judicial Officers shall wear full suit, full sleeve coat/ half sleeve coat, sober colour shirt with full sleeves, tie and shoes, and
  - (ii) the women Judicial Officers shall wear dress as indicated in (i) to (iii) of the Sub-rule (c), with full sleeve coat/ half sleeve coat befitting the dignity of a Judicial Officer.
