Ref: Hon'ble High Court's Circular No.14/2023 in R.O.C. No. 590/S.O/2023, dated 30.9.2023.

The Hon'ble High Court has issued a Circular in the reference cited directing all the Unit heads to take necessary and effective steps for implementation of the provisions contained in Sec.12-B of Advocates welfare Act 1987 to ensure that new stamp worth Rs.20/- (Rupees twenty only) superscribed in Telugu language as "Nyayavadula Sakshema Nidhi" be affixed on every interlocutory application and other miscellaneous petitions to be filed by the Advocates, with effect from 5.10.2023 and no interlocutory application or other miscellaneous petitions shall be accepted without such stamp.

It is brought to the notice of the undersigned by the members of the Bar Association, Nellore that they have not received the new stamps worth Rs.20/- from the Andhra Pradesh Advocates' Welfare Fund Committee and unable to distribute the same to all the Advocates and requested to issue instructions to all the presiding officers in the District in this regard.

Hence, all the Judicial Officers working in the SPSR Nellore District are hereby permitted to accept the interlocutory applications and other miscellaneous petitions from the Advocates with an undertaking affidavit to be given by the Advocate concerned that he/she will affix the stamps on the said petitions as and when received by them from the Bar Association, Nellore.
