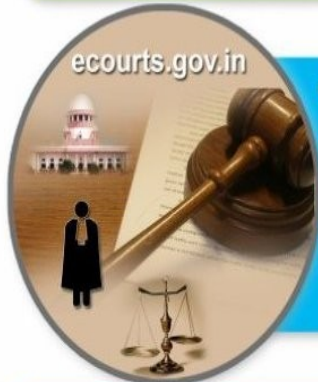
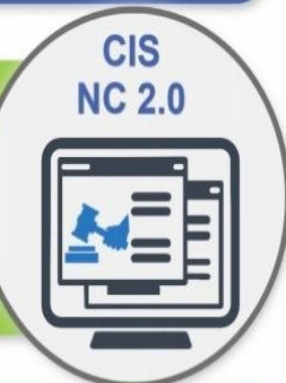

MALAPPURAM DISTRICT MAP DISTRICT COURT COMPLEX

Manjeri was the part of Malabar District under the British rule before independence. The Malabar District was divided into two Districts, North and South Malabar with Head Quarters at Tellicherry and Calicut. In the South Malabar, there were Sub Courts at Calicut, Palghat, Ottapalam and District Magistrate's Court at Nairath, Chovvur, Manjeri, Parappanagudi, Pattambi, Ponnani, Tinnai and Pottanamuzha.

After the formation of Malappuram District on 16-6-1999, a District Court started functioning at Kozhikode with effect from 25-5-1970. Sri.K.M.Muhammedali was the first District & Sessions Judge of this district. The Court was shifted to the Court Complex at Manjeri on 1-2-1974. The building for the court was inaugurated by the Honorable Mr. Justice P. Govindan Nair, Chief Justice, High Court of Kerala. Sri. K.Ramaswami, the Minister for Home provided over the facilities.

In Manjeri Judicial District there are 24 Courts are functioning. The Courts are situated in various locations in the district such as Manjeri, Malappuram, Tinnai, Pottanamuzha, Parappanagudi, Ponnani, Tinnai and Nilambur. Malappuram district Revenue head quarter is situated at Malappuram, Judicial head quarter is situated at Manjeri.

National Judicial Data Grid

- NJDG public access page, gives the consolidated figures of pendency of cases in District Judiciary across the country.
- Statistical data is automatically updated every day from the data of respective Court Complexes covered under the eCourts.
- Pending Civil and Criminal Cases segregated into age wise categories of up to 2 years, between 2 to 5 years, between 5 to 10 years and more than 10 years is shown.
- Information pertaining to Institution and Disposal of cases and also the cases filed by senior citizens and women is shown.
- Monitoring alerts like all cases listed today across the country and all the cases where no date is updated or a date more than 3 months later is updated.
- All the above referred statistics is provided in drill-down manner, from State to District, District to a Court establishment and then to the individual Court.
- NJDG contains information of 2.41 Crore pending cases out of approximately 8.05 Crore cases of District Judiciary.
