Judicial Department (Civil) – Manjeri District – Establishment – Retaining of one additional increment granted pursuant to the recommendations of the Shetty Commission Report to the posts in the Ministerial Cadre – Sanctioned – Orders issued.

Read: - 1. G.O.(MS) No.134/2013/Home dated 25-05-2013.

2. Judgment in WP(C)No.35714/2019 dated 27-11-2024 of the Honourable High Court of Kerala.

ORDER No.B1-19174/2024

As per GO(MS)No.134/2013 dated 25-05-2013, the government had sanctioned one additional increment to the 19 posts in ministerial cadre of judicial department with effect from 01-04-2003, in compliance to the recommendations of Shetty Commission Report.

Consequently one additional increment was added to the basic pay of the employees who come under the 19 posts in the ministerial cadre, with effect from 01-04-2003.

But the additional increment granted to some employees as per order read 1st has not been effected to retain due to the fixation under Rule 28A Part I of KSR consequent to their promotion to higher post.

As per judgment cited 2 above, the Honourable High Court of Kerala held "there will be a declaration to the effect that the petitioner as well as the members of the 6th respondent would be entitled to retain one additional increment granted pursuant to the recommendations of the Shetty Commission Report and Ext.P1 Government Order, as long as he holds the posts in the ministerial cadre".

Hence, in the light of the above, sanction is hereby accorded to regulate the pay of the aforesaid employees in Ministerial Cadre of this Civil Judicial District by ensuring that the one additional increment granted w.e.f. 01-04-2003 as per order cited 1 above is retained as long as they hold the posts in the ministerial cadre.

The fixation shall be made with utmost care. The affidavit to the effect that in the event of incumbent's pay, leave salary or pension or any other item having been fixed in a manner contrary to the provisions contained in the rules, as detected subsequently, any excess payment so made shall be refunded by the incumbent to the Government either by adjustment against future payment due to him or in cash and that the incumbent is a member of KCJSO shall be obtained in advance before encashing the arrears.
