## Note:-

- 1. If any other holidays are declared in this month, Judicial Magistrate First Class (Court No. 01) and Judicial Magistrate First Class (Court No. 02) Sakoli, Tumsar, Mohadi, Lakhandur, Lakhani and Pauni shall attend remand work and urgent matters of their respective Courts.
- 2. All Officers shall note that there will be **no change in this order except** compelling circumstance and they shall follow it strictly.
- 3. It is further directed that if any Judicial Officers who is assigned the duty of attending the remand work and urgent matter wishes to leave head quarters on the day on which he has to attend the remand work and the urgent matters as per above rotation he shall obtain the consent of any other Judicial Officer at that particular station who is willing to attend his work on his application for seeking the permission to leave head quarter before it is submitted to the Hon'ble Principal District ans Sessions Judge, Bhandara for sanction. While doing so the intimation of the same shall also be given to this officer without fail.
- 4. It is reported that the Magistrates who have remand duty, often without taking consent of other Magistrate, seek permission to leave

head quarter, Such practice shall be deprecated and Magistrate should refrain themselves from making such application without consent of other Magistrate. In such circumstances, the said Magistrate shall inform the undersigned without fail before leaving head quater.

- In case of any exigency, in which the Judicial Officer to whom remand duty is 5. assigned as above, has to leave the head quarter without permission of the Hon'ble Principal District and Sessions Judge, Bhandara then any of the Judicial Magistrate, (F.C.) available at the head quarter shall attend remand and urgent matters.
- In view of Office Order issued by Hon'ble Principal District and Sessions Judge, dated 11th No.B-16(1)/604/1987 BHR, August, 2017 Bhandara authorising the Judicial Officer for urgent Criminal matters during the absence of Judicial Officer of concerned court on working days and same arrangement to do the remand work and urgent matters on holidays 2nd and 4th Saturday's and Sunday's under the intimation the concerned Courts.
