<u>ORDER</u>

This petition has been filed by the petitioners/accused U/s.438 of Code of Criminal Procedure seeking anticipatory bail.

2. The Nitty-Gritty of the prosecution case is as follows:

The petitioner No.1 herein and complainant's daughter are husband and wife respectively. After their marriage on 09.09.2021, the bride has been staying in her parent's home. The petitioners harassed and ill treated the bride by demanding dowry. Further the petitioner No.1 having illicit intimacy with another women. Based on the complaint CSR No.119 of 2024 was given. No FUR was registered so far.

3. Heard both sides.

4. The points for determination is the can anticipatory bail be granted to the petitioners?

Answer :

5. The records are perused. The petitioner No.1 and complainant's daughter are husband and wife. After their marriage the petitioner No.1 harassed his wife demanding dowry. The bride has been staying at her parental home. So the dispute being between the married couples. Further no FIR so far registered against the petitioners. It cannot be inferred that the petitioners are under reasonable apprehension at the hands of respondent. So at this premature stage anticipatory bail cannot be granted. In the result the petition is liable to be dismissed.

In fine, the petition is dismissed.
