**ORDER**

This petition has been filed by the petitioner/accused U/s.439 of Code of Criminal Procedure seeking bail.

**2. The Nitty-Gritty of the prosecution case is as follows :-**

On 09.02.2024 at about 9.00 p.m., when the complainant was returning his home, the petitioner and other accused assaulted the complainant indiscriminately with knife and Iron Rod. Thereafter they intimidated him. Hence the case registered against them U/s.147, 148, 294(b), 342, 324, 506(ii) and 307 of IPC.

4. The points for determination is that can the petitioner be released on bail ?

**Answer :**

5. The FIR and reply given by the Police are perused. The FIR prima facie reveal that the petitioner and co accused formed into the unlawful assembly and assaulted the complainant indiscriminately with knife and Iron Rod. Whereby caused severe injuries on the complainant. The prosecution submitted that the investigation is underway if released on bail he would abscond and tamper with prosecution witnesses. Since the investigation is pending and it is premature stage to release the petitioner on bail further as claimed by the prosecution there is possibilities for the petitioner to abscond from the clutches of law and thereby hampering investigation. Considering the above facts, the petition is liable to be dismissed.

**In result, this bail petition is dismissed.**
