<u>ORDER</u>

This petition has been filed by the petitioner/accused U/s.439 of Code of Criminal Procedure seeking bail.

2. The Nitty-Gritty of the prosecution case is as follows :-

The petitioner has been charge sheeted U/s.341, 294(b), 354(D) and 4 of TNPHW Act. The final report was taken on file as C.C.No.86/2017, wherein Non Bailable Warrant was pending against him for two years and remanded on Non Bailable Warrant on 07.03.2024.

4. The points for determination is that can the petitioner be released on bail ?

5. The final report against the petitioner was already taken on file as C.C.No.86/2017 and the case is pending for Trial.
