This petition has been filed by the petitioner/accused U/s.439 of Code of Criminal Procedure seeking bail.

2. The Nitty-Gritty of the prosecution case is as follows:-

On 29.03.2024 at about 11.00 p.m., the petitioner and co accused allegedly murdered the deceased namely Satheesh in front of the petitioner's house. So the case was registered against them U/s.294(b) and 302 of IPC.

5. The FIR and reply given by the Police are perused.
