This petition has been filed by the petitioner/accused U/s.438 of Code of Criminal Procedure seeking anticipatory bail.

2. The Nitty-Gritty of the prosecution case is as follows:-

On 17.03.2024 during night Bicycle, Electric motor and Tiles cutting machine were stolen from the house of the complainant. The value of the properties in total is at Rs.40,000/-. So case registered U/s.457 and 380 of IPC.
