### TRACKING OF CASE STATUS:-

- •Advocates and other stakeholders can track their case and obtain information of the Cases on:
- o services.ecourts.gov.in
- o court.mah.nic.in (Bilingual website.)
- On e-Courts Website: Advocates and Stakeholders can track the Status of Case by CNR Number, Case No., FIR No., Party Name, Advocate Name, Filing Number of the Case, Act Name, Case Type Wise and Village Name.
- Cause List can also be viewed on these websites.
- Advocates and other stakeholders can obtain copies of Orders/Judgments of Court from these websites.
- Copies or Orders/Judgments can be downloaded by Case Number, Court Number of the Court which passes the Order/Judgment, Party Name and Order Date.
- •Status of Case can be tracked with the Mobile Application : eCourts Services.
- •Status of Case can be tracked through Pull SMS.
- •Case Status can be tracked by scanning QR Code of Case with QR Code Scanner in eCourts Services Mobile Application.

- •Android /iOs Mobile Application can be freely downloaded by the Judges, Advocates and other stakeholders from the Google Store / Apple Store.
- •Advocates can get the details of the Cases anytime from anywhere.
- •QR Code is available for each case. These QR Codes can be scanned with the mobile application to get information of Case.
- •Stakeholders can generate Cause List from anywhere using this mobile application.
- •'My Cases' is the Best Management feature of this mobile application.
- •Advocates can save all /important cases as 'My Cases'. They can obtain information of these Cases just by clicking these cases.
- •'My Cases' feature is a Portfolio Management Tool for Advocates.

IN THE **ECOURT**  $\circ$  OR CODE SCANNER **SERVICES MOBILE** APPLICATION: Unique QR Code is available for every case on the e-Courts website. These QR Codes can be downloaded, printed or pasted. By scanning QR Code with the help of the QR Code Scanner in e-Court Services Mobile Application, the current status of the cases can be obtained.


## •Status updates can be tracked from SMS and Email sent by Courts to every registered Advocate.


