NOTIFICATION

Sub: Calling for applications to fill up of the posts of the Special Judicial Second Class Magistrates in the Unit of Warangal — Regarding.

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for filling up of the posts of Special Judicial Second Class Magistrates in the Unit of Warangal for a period of one year, as detailed below :

The Special Judicial Magistrates of Second Class will hold morning courts from 7.30 am to 10.30 am for 5 days in a week (Monday to Friday). They will be paid a consolidated honorarium of Rs. 45,000/- Per Month and Rs.5,000/- P.M. towards Conveyance.

1. QUALIFICATIONS:

- (i) The incumbent must have held any post in Telangana Higher Judicial service or State Judicial Service and retired or resigned; or
- (ii) Who has held a post in the Telangana Judicial Ministerial Service not below the rank of Head Clerk / Superintendent of District Munsif Court and possesses a Law Degree; or
- (iii) Who has held a post of Section Officer and above in Telangana High Court Service and has a Law Degree; or
- (iv) A non-practicing Advocate with a practice in the Bar of not less than five years and who is above 45 years of Age; or
- (v) Any retired Gazetted Officer possessing Law Degree or who has passed the Criminal Judicial Test (Full test consisting of the I.P.C. and Cr.P.C.) conducted by the Telangana Public Service Commission and who has exercised Magisterial Powers during his tenure of Service for not less than three years.
- (vi) A suitable retired Judicial Officer is preferred.

AND

- (vii) Who has at least two years to attain the age of 65 years as on 01.07.2025

2. **DIS-QUALIFICATIONS:**

A PERSON :-


- (i) Who is a practicing Advocate
- (ii) Who is a member of any State or Local Authority; or
- (iii) Who is a member of the State Legislature or the Parliament; or
- (iv) A person who having held an office under the State or the Union Government or any Local authority, was removed or dismissed or compulsorily retired from Service subjected to any other major penalty for misconduct; or
- (v) A person who has been convicted and sentenced by a Court for an offence involving moral delinquency or is charged with any offence constituting moral turpitude and proceedings are pending ; or
- (vi) A person adjudicated as an insolvent or an un-discharged insolvent ; or
- (vii) A contractor or a businessman or one interested in a subsisting contract or any work being done for State/Central Government shall not be eligible.

3. **REVOCAION OF POWERS OF SPECIAL MAGISTRATES:**

- (i) On appointment and while in service, powers conferred on a Special Metropolitan Magistrate / Special Judicial Magistrate of Second Class can be revoked if he/she failed to attend three consecutive sittings of the Court without a written permission of the Chief Judicial Magistrate.
- (ii) A Special Metropolitan Magistrate/Special Judicial Magistrate of Second Class stands automatically removed on attaining the age of 65 years.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- (i) The duly filled in applications shall be submitted strictly in the prescribed proforma, along with all the necessary copies of documents, such as duly attested qualification certificates, retirement proceedings etc., to this Office on or before 19/9/25 by 05.00 p.m. and applications received after due date and time will not be entertained.
- (ii) No TA will be paid for candidates for journey performed in connection with recruitment.
- (iii) The appointing authority reserves the right to cancel the notification without assigning any reason thereof.
- (iv) Applications with insufficient information, without necessary enclosures and without proper attestation will be summarily rejected and no correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
- (v) This office will not be responsible for any delay caused by the postal or any other service, viz., courier service, etc.,
