This petition is coming for hearing before me on this day in the presence of Thiru.R.Velmurugan, Advocate for the petitioner and of Public Prosecutor for the respondent and this Court made the following

**ORDER**

Heard both sides.

This petition is filed U/s.438 of Cr.P.C, for seeking Anticipatory bail.

The Learned Counsel for the Petitioner/Accused has filed the Anticipatory application and stated that the Petitioner/Accused has been charged by the Respondent Police U/Ss.147, 148, 341, 294(b), 323, 324, 506(ii) and 307 of IPC for the alleged occurrence took place on 10.03.2024 and FIR was registered on 11.03.2024.

The Learned Counsel for the Petitioner/Accused has contended that one TPL Company has license to transport the mines but they illegally also doing the same. Some persons asked why they illegally do it. So petty quarrel with clash between the parties. 4 persons injured in the occurrence, 3 of them treated as O.P., 1 person is treated as IP because there is injury in the nose. The investigation is almost completed. Hence, prays to allow the petition.

The Learned Public Prosecutor objected on the ground that the as per FIR, there is 7 accused involved in this case, the detention order served to A1. The Petitioner/Accused assaulted the injured with hand. The injured is still IP because there is fracture in the nose. The investigation has not yet been completed. Hence, he strongly objected to grant Anticipatory bail to the Petitioner/Accused.

Considering the submissions made by both sides. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and other aspects and gravity of the offences and the investigation has not yet been completed, this Court is not inclined to grant Anticipatory bail to the Petitioner/Accused at this stage. Hence, the petition is dismissed.
